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Contractor:

Responsible for Spill Prevention and Cleanup

- 24-7 Bypass pump monitoring every ½ hour
- Pre-construction Spill prevention and mitigation meeting
- Contractor Staff training
- Mitigation/Spill Kits on site
- Require spill prevention and mitigation Plan on site – agenda item at weekly progress meetings
- Notification check list
 - County Project manager
 - Fire Marshall
 - Virginia DEQ
 - Warning Signs and Fencing as appropriate

DPWES-Capital Facilities:

Responsible for Oversight and Communication

- Develop New Spill Prevention, Control & Countermeasures Requirements
- Develop New Temporary Bypass Specifications
- Conduct New DPWES/CAP Training
- Update the DPWES Emergency Notification Protocols to include Additional Notification if Spill enters stream:
 - Residents & HOAs
 - Supervisor's office
 - National Response Center
- Obtain Third Party Environmental oversight on certain projects to observe spill clean-up by Contractor.
