^{*} The facility has been closed for rentals due to COVID-19. It is not anticipated that rentals will resume during FY 2021, therefore the cost per rental cannot be calculated for FY 2021.

^{**} Due to minimal use of the center during FY 2018 as a result of the renovation and maintenance project, survey data was not collected and reported for FY 2018. As it is not anticipated that the center will be open for rentals and community use during FY 2021, survey data is not expected to be collected.

^{***} A large renovation and maintenance project began in FY 2018. FY 2019 rental engagements does not reflect a full year of operations. With the renovations now complete, it was anticipated that FY 2020 and FY 2021 would include full years of the center being available for community members and organizations to rent and utilize; however, due to COVID-19 the center was closed for rentals in the latter part of FY 2020 and it is anticipated to be closed for the duration of FY 2021. It is hoped that center rentals will resume to normal levels in FY 2022, but staff will continue to monitor circumstances and public health guidance to make final decisions regarding the center's operating status.
