Staff Reports

- The next foreclosure information meeting, which provides information for tenants, is January 27, 2009. Liaison Johnson provided flyers for Commissioners to distribute within their network.
- Liaison Johnson provided an update regarding the rental policy that will allow qualified renters in Fannie Mae owned foreclosed properties to stay in their homes. This policy is expected to be fully operational before the end of January. Renters occupying any type of single-family property will be eligible including residents of two-to four-unit properties, condos, co-ops, single-family detached homes and manufactured housing. Eligible renters will be offered a new month-to-month lease with Fannie Mae, or financial assistance to help them move if they choose to vacate the property.
- The 2009 Regular Session of the Virginia General Assembly started on Wednesday, January 14, 2009. Staff will keep the Commissioner updated regarding tenant-landlord legislation.
- No questions or comments regarding the statistical reports.

Commission Matters

- There are currently three vacancies, one landlord, one citizen, and one tenant.

 - A Consumer Focus Program will be developed for September broadcast. Staff will
 submit the communication request to Channel 16. This program will explore
 maintenance obligations and responsibilities as it relates to housekeeping standards
 and landlord obligations to provide extermination services. The bed bug epidemic
 will be explored.
 - The Channel 16 Advisory Committee will present a menu of items the Commission would like covered in this program.
 - Commissioners will attend educational events with staff and will inform Liaison Johnson when they are available. Commissioners will clarify what role and message they would like to convey when attending outreach activities. Commissioner Kocsis will attend the tenant event on 1/29/09.
