

WHEREAS, April 13-17 has been designated National Community Development Week to celebrate the federal Community Development Block Grant program now in its 45th year and the HOME Investment Partnerships program now in its 28th year; and

WHEREAS, Fairfax County has received \$236.5 million from the CDBG program over the past 45 years and \$55.5 million over the past 28 years from the HOME program, supporting the development of housing that is affordable and benefits low- to moderate-income people, including older adults, people with disabilities, those experiencing chronic or frequent homelessness and children; and

WHEREAS, the Community Development Block Grant program and the HOME Investment Partnerships program foster a strong network among local government, residents, businesses and nonprofit organizations working to meet the needs of Fairfax County residents; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Fairfax County Board of Supervisors, on behalf of all residents of Fairfax County, does hereby designate April 13-17, 2020, as

Community Development Week

in Fairfax County and urges all residents to recognize the importance and achievements of the Community Development Block Grant program and the HOME Investment Partnerships program in improving the quality of life in Fairfax County and throughout the U.S.
