Criteria: Candidates must be 18 years of age or older, own property and reside within the Burgundy Village Community.

Proof of Candidacy: Must provide documentation for each of the following:

- Proof of age
- Property ownership
- Proof of residency within the Burgundy community

Examples of documentation can include, but are not limited to a driver's license, military ID, birth certificate, or tax records.

- Una fotografía

Esta información y la fotografía será enviada a los votantes de la comunidad de Burgundy Village. Se adjunta un formulario opcional que se puede utilizar para aplicar.

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Criterios: Los candidatos deben tener 18 años o mayores, poseer bienes y residir dentro de la comunidad de Burgundy Village.

Prueba de candidatura: Debe presentar documentación de cada uno de los siguientes:

- Prueba de edad
- Prueba de propiedad
- Comprobante de domicilio dentro de la comunidad de Burgundy

Ejemplos de la documentación que pueden incluir, pero no se limitan a, certificado de nacimiento, licencia de conducir, identificación militar o registros de impuestos.

Por favor envíe la documentación anterior vía correo certificado, por fax, correo electrónico o presentar en persona para ser estampada con fecha y notariada.
