Capital Projects Timeline

1. Update FCPS Capital Improvement Program
 - Community engagement begins at onset of program and continues throughout
2. Establish School Bond Referendum
3. Planning/Design
 - Procure architect RFP
 - Meetings - School Board, Design Feedback and Engagement Committee, PTA, Land Use Committee, and Community
4. “2232” or Rezoning
 - Planning Commission
 - Fairfax County Board of Supervisors
5. Procure construction contractors
 - Meetings - School Board, PTA, and Community
6. Construction
 - Meetings - School Board and PTA
