### Rolling Valley Park and Ride

**9220 Old Keene Mill Road, Burke, VA 22015**

*Near intersection of Old Keene Mill Road and Keene Drive*

**Total Parking Spaces:** 664, FREE Parking

- Fairfax Connector Route 310 to Franconia-Springfield and Huntington Metrorail Stations
  - **Fare:** \$2.00 (SmarTrip® or cash)
- Metrobus Routes 18G and 18P to the Pentagon
  - **Fare:** Express \$4.25 (SmarTrip® or cash)

### Saratoga Park and Ride

**Barta Road, Springfield, VA 22153**

*Near intersection of Barta Road and Fairfax County Parkway*

**Total Parking Spaces:** 500, FREE Parking

- Fairfax Connector Route 394 to Pentagon
  - **Fare:** Express \$4.25 (SmarTrip® or cash)
- Fairfax Connector Route 494 to Franconia-Springfield Metro Station and Tysons
  - **Fare:** \$2.00 (SmarTrip® or cash)
