RENOVATION STATUS REPORT

Summer 2023

On Dec. 31, 2022, the Mount Vernon Rec Center closed its doors in preparation for a major renovation and expansion expected to last two years. The project will include a complete renovation of the current building, mechanical systems, and expansion. When complete, the state-of-the-art facility will include two NHL-sized ice rinks, a two-level dedicated fitness area, an elevated indoor track, swimming pool, climbing wall and multi-purpose rooms. Anticipated completion is scheduled in the spring of 2025.



Project Update:



The majority of construction to date has consisted of demolition of portions of the existing structure. Many existing interior walls have been removed, and portions of the slab have been cut to accommodate drain lines for the relocated and expanded locker rooms. There is extensive demolition around the pool area to facilitate updated drainage and mechanical systems.





Earthwork has commenced between the existing building and the parking lot to accommodate building expansion in that direction.



The original entrance off Belle View Boulevard conflicts with the new rink and is being removed. The relocated entrance will align with existing parking and now serves as the project's construction entrance.
