The Bea Malone Small Business Award has been established by the Small Business Commission to honor its past Chairman, the late Beatrice “Bea” Malone, who diligently served the Commission, Fairfax County, and the small businesses therein for many years, leaving us in 2015.

Who may be nominated?

Any small business is eligible provided it meets the following criteria:

1. Meet the definition of a small business based on the Commonwealth of Virginia’s SWaM (Small, Women-owned, and Minority-owned) program:
 - Small Business (at least 51% independently owned and controlled by one or more individuals who are U.S. citizens, has 250 or fewer employees, or average annual gross receipts of \$10 million or less averaged over the previous three years)
 - Women-owned (at least 51% owned by one or more women who are U.S. citizens or legal resident aliens)
 - Minority-owned (at least 51% owned by one or more minority individuals who are U.S. citizens or legal resident aliens)

3. Has a tangible record of community service in Fairfax County
