








Park Background

- McLean Central Park is classified as a Local Park
- Park boundaries have expanded over time with land acquisitions
- The community center, library, and park provide a campus setting with shared resources and programming




Approved Master Plan

- McLean Central Park
 Master Plan Revision was approved in 2013
- New facilities included an amphitheater, drop-off area, fitness equipment, picnic area, bocce court, game tables, seating areas, disc golf, & trail improvements



Public Comment on Draft Concept

- Preserve and maintain green space & existing park facilities
- More in favor of an amphitheater than opposed
- Support for expanding/consolidating playgrounds
- Improve all courts and update pickleball layouts
- Mixed support for fitness area
- Limited support for bocce court & game tables
- Advocation for incorporating public art




