



ACCOTINK STREAM VALLEY TRAIL

This section of the trail connects on the southern end under the Route 236 / Beltway interchange to the trail into Wakefield Park and at the northwestern end through the parking lot at Thaiss Park to the trail along Pickett Road. The distance from Route 236 to Pickett Road is approximately 4.2 miles.

Access points for this section of trail are from the public parks along the route as well as from neighborhood streets that intersect the trail as shown on the map. There is parking at Thaiss Park on Pickett Road and at Eakin Community Park at Prosperity Avenue and off Tobin Road. Eakin Community Park includes a picnic area and playground, garden plots, tennis courts, ballfields and volleyball courts. Restroom facilities are provided near the parking lot off Tobin Road during the spring, summer, and fall.

This section of the trail is a mixture of asphalt and stonedust surfaces; the portions under King Arthur Road and under the Route 236 overpass are concrete. The trail is very level and stream crossings are a combination of bridges, open bottom culverts, and concrete bridge spans. There are at-grade crossings at Woodburn Road, Prosperity Avenue, and Barkley Drive.
