In addition to the below Home-Based Business use standards contained in the Zoning Ordinance, applicants must also comply with Virginia Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services (VDACS) and Fairfax County Health Department (FCHD) regulations. New businesses, including ones run from the home, must file a business license application within 75 days of the date the business began. Business license information is available at the Property and License Division at 703-222-8234, option 4. This home-based business permit is a zoning approval for the use and not approval of the food type and how it is produced. The applicant is responsible to be compliant with all other applicable regulations.
