






Mill Pond Falls, Aberjona River, Winchester, MA

This fish ladder retrofit of Winchester's distinctive horseshoeshaped dam allows fish to migrate around a dam by providing enough water so that fish can swim up to the other side of the dam. The velocity of water is controlled to prevent pushing fish back downstream. The fish ladder is located on the right side of the dam, facing upstream. Look for the metal grating by the side of the bridge to see the concrete channel of the ladder underneath, the flowing water, and the herring during migration.

#### Bird of prey best practices

Various

A managed wetland can maintain – and enhance bird of prey habitat with:

- Edge buffer zones which preserve existing trees often used for nesting. See <u>BLM guidelines</u> and <u>VA DWR Raptor guidelines</u>.
- Improved aquatic habitat (pond) as a food source.
- Logs, former beaver dams, woody debris, new nature-based solutions (NBS), process based restoration BMPs, and other perching areas can provide more locations for undisturbed feeding (photo above).






#### **ANNOUNCEMENT**


