# Community Assessment: Children 18 Years and Under

In 2000, a Community Assessment was conducted jointly by Fairfax County, the City of Fairfax, the City of Falls Church, and the Fairfax–Falls Church United Way to gather information about people in our community and to assist in human services planning. In September 2000, the survey was mailed to 11,200 households in the two Cities and the County. The response rate was 6,859 households or 63 percent after compensating for vacant housing and incorrect addresses. This was the second Community Assessment; the first survey was conducted in 1995.



This publication profiles children, age 18 years or younger, and households containing children in the five Human Services Regions, the Cities of Fairfax and Falls Church, and the Total Area. The tables contain person level data about age, sex, race/ethnicity, English proficiency, day care status, poverty rates, health insurance coverage, and mental health issues. The tables also contain household information to include family structure, language spoken at home, Internet access, income, financial need, housing costs, and percent of income spent on housing.
