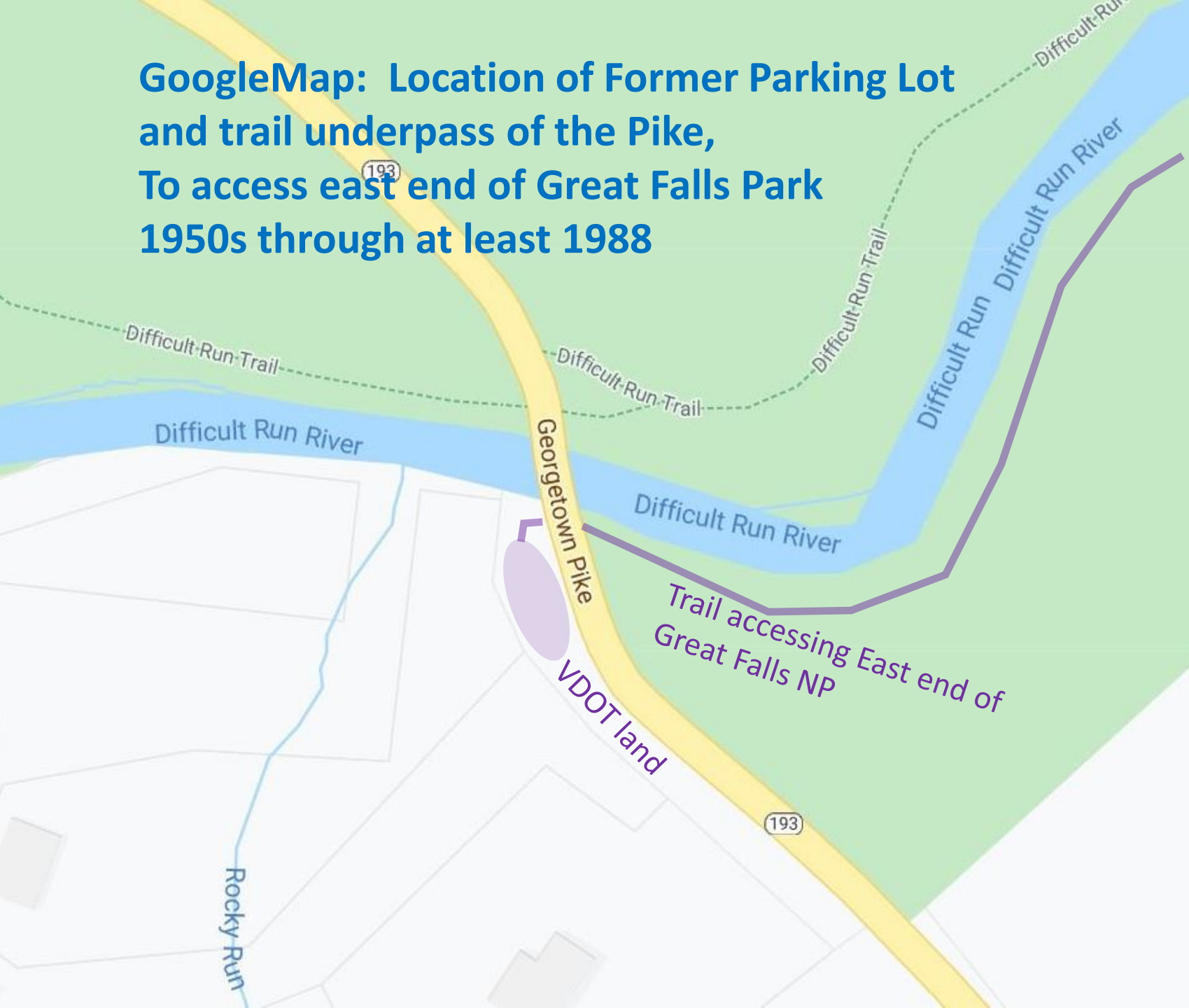


GoogleMap: Georgetown Pike at Difficult Run
