8		AN ORDINANCE to amend the Fairfax County Code by adding a new
9		Section 6-1-2.2 relating to loaded rifles and shotguns in motor vehicles.
10	Be it	ordained by the Board of Supervisors of Fairfax County:
11	1.	That a new Section 6-1-2.2 of the Fairfax County Code is enacted as follows:
12		Section 6-1-2.2. Transporting loaded rifle or shotgun
13		(a) It shall be unlawful for any person to transport, possess or carry a loaded
14		shotgun or loaded rifle in any vehicle on any public street, road or highway
15		within the county. Any violation of this section shall be punishable by a fine of
16		<u>not more than \$100.</u>
17		(b) The provisions of this section shall not apply to duly authorized law
18		enforcement officers or military personnel in the performance of their lawful
19		duties, to any person who reasonably believes that a loaded rifle or shotgun is
20		necessary for his personal safety in the course of his employment or business,
21		nor to any person transporting a malfunctioning rifle or shotgun for the purpose
22		of having it repaired or otherwise rendered safe.
23	2.	That the provisions of this ordinance are severable, and if any provision of
24		this ordinance or any application thereof is held invalid, that invalidity shall
25		not affect the other provisions or applications of this ordinance that can be
26		given effect without the invalid provision or application.
27		
28	3.	That the provisions of this ordinance shall take effect on January 1, 2019.
