

Status of 2018 ZOAWP Amendments

Total of 74% of items have been adopted, authorized, or addressed

Major Accomplishments

- Small-Scale Production Establishments (zMOD)
- Older Adult Accommodations
 - Continuing Care Facilities
 - New PCC Zoning District
 - Adult Day Care Centers
 - Health Care Advisory Board Procedures
- Sign Ordinance Rewrite (zMOD)
- Wireless Facilities
- Consolidated Draft of Use Regulations (zMOD)

Proposed 2019 ZOAWP Initiatives

(Attachments 2 and 3)

13 main initiatives with 27 individual topic areas Timing:

- <u>First Tier</u> Researched and presented to DPC within the first half of FY2019, and potentially authorized/adopted in that timeframe
- <u>Second Tier</u> Researched and presented to DPC within the second half of FY2020, and potentially authorized/adopted in that timeframe
- <u>zMOD</u> Complete new ZO to be presented for public hearings in spring/summer of 2020. Incremental drafts released along the way
