#### **Public Safety Overtime Main Categories**


- Overtime Pay additional compensation for hours in excess of regularly scheduled hours. Overtime for law enforcement personnel shall be time worked or on paid leave in excess of 86 hours during his/her 14-consecutive day work period. Overtime for fire protection personnel shall be time worked or on paid leave in excess of 212 hours during his/her 28-consecutive day work period.
- Callback Pay additional compensation if an employee is off duty and called to return to work after departing from the workplace.
- Shift Extension/Holdover Pay additional compensation if an employee is required to say past their regularly schedule hours due to an emergency or staffing shortages.
- Fair Labor Standards Act (FLSA) Pay additional compensation for all hours worked over the FLSA threshold for overtime, as outlined in the definition of overtime.
- On-Call additional compensation if an employee is required to remain available, outside his/her scheduled work hours to report to work within a reasonable time if called upon to do so.
- **Court Overtime** additional compensation if court time falls on the employee's scheduled day off or begins more than two hours prior to the employee's schedule shift.
- Holiday Pay additional compensation for working on a scheduled holiday, or compensation if a holiday falls on a regularly schedule day off.
- Administrative Emergency Pay additional compensation due to an employee being required to work because of an emergency, in many cases this occurs when the county has been closed due to a weather event.

### **Public Safety Overtime Primary Drivers**

- Minimum Staffing Requirements 24 hours a day/7 days a week
  - Manage vacancies, sick leave, annual leave, injury leave
- Training Requirements
- Extension of Emergency Events
- Compensation Increases, New Positions
- Fair Labor Standards Act (FLSA)






#### Major Callback/Overtime categories include:

- Diversion First



### Police Overtime Categories (FY 2019)




#### **Major Overtime categories include:**

- Other essential administrative overtime




