How can we use technology to better connect the supply of accessible housing with those in need of such accommodations?


Accessible Housing Demand

- Demand far outweighs supply
- Lack of comprehensive and centralized resource on supply
- Unit features do not always match individuals' needs properly

Existing Housing Supply


- Lack of information on private and nonprofit organization housing resources
- Insufficient data on applicants that would better connect them to units
- May require additional modifications
- Accessible features may exceed the needs of the renters

Overview of System Architecture



- Includes private, nonprofit, and commercial housing data
- User-friendly website and integrated data center improve matching accuracy and speed

Overview of System Architecture (continued)



- Inform further system modifications based on user behavior and matching results
- Demand-based funding investment to improve efficient matching

Data Feeds and User Definitions



Property owners

- Provide detailed descriptions for available properties
- Select available accessibility features, including a variety of reasonable accommodations



Web feeds

- Add publicly available data on relevant housing websites through webscraping
- Link direct sources of already existing data on a regular basis



Prospective applicants

 Apply to program waitlists, identifying specific special needs and modifications





Renters

- Explore available housing options
- Filter properties by accessible features

Search Engine of Available Rental Properties

- Name
- Contact Information
- Income
- Disability type (Hearing / Mobility / Sight)
- Range of distance considerable
- Accessibility needs

Other features not listed

- Available rentals
- Feature filters include:
 - Range of rent
 - Distance to work/school/etc.
 - Accessibility features
- Direct contact information (for private owners only)



Future Features

- Search engine will track user behavior, helping improve feature definitions
- Matching algorithm will improve search engine and better connect the supply of accessible housing
- Analytics dashboard will include user behavior, demand, and market proportions
- Expand system to include homeless, displaced, and elderly populations
