Huntley Meadows Park Natural Resource Management Plan Scope of Work

The Park Authority will complete a Natural Resources Management Plan (NRMP) and associated surveys for Huntley Meadows Park, as part of the feasibility to include the park within the Virginia Natural Area Preserve system. The NRMP that will be developed will consider options and provide recommended implementation actions for ecological restoration. The scope of the project will include the entirety of Huntley Meadows Park. The project will be managed by Natural Resource Branch (NRB) staff.

The period of performance will be 18 months. The completion schedule assumes a July 1, 2017 start date.

Goals

The project will be conducted in accordance with FCPA Policy 201, Natural Resources. It will also help fulfill recommended actions 1, 2, 3, 5, 6, 10, 13, 15, 16, 24, and 26 in the agency-wide Natural Resource Management Plan. It will produce a plan that will be

used to manage, restore, and protect the natural resources of Huntley Meadows Park. The NRMP will inform the Master Plan for the park.

Objectives

The following project objectives will achieve the goals identified above.

- 1. Manage project to meet goals.
- 2. Prepare NRMP.
- 3. Conduct planning-level ecological surveys to inform NRMP.
- 4. Conduct hydrology study in targeted areas of the park.
- 5. Determine feasibility of Natural Area Preserve (NAP) and alternatives recommendations, as needed.

Tasks

The NRB will manage contractors to achieve project objectives. Project tasks will be performed to complete deliverables according to specifications outlined in this document.

- 1. Manage the project to include coordination with sites, contractor selection and management, quality assurance, stakeholders, and other factors.
- 2. Coordinate FCPA comments for NRMP outline to contractor.
- 3. Coordinate FCPA comments for 50% draft NRMP and provide to contractor.
- 4. Coordinate FCPA comments for 90% draft NRMP and provide to contractor.
- 5. Coordinate contractor(s) and staff for planning-level ecological survey(s) and ensure information is included in NRMP.
- 6. Coordinate contractor for hydrology study.
- 7. Consult with Virginia Department of Conservation and Recreation (DCR) and U.S. National Park Service (NPS) to request the removal of deed restrictions for DCR concurrence with NAP. Provide a list of potential alternative actions if concurrence among DCR, FCPA, and NPS is not achieved.

Specifications

- The NRMP will be compliant with DCR NAP standards.
- The NRMP will incorporate results from planning-level ecological surveys and existing, suitable FCPA data.
- The NRMP will include water level management for habitat management for the park's central wetland.
- The NRMP will use natural vegetation community data to delineate management units.
- The NRMP will identify restoration, enhancement, and/or maintenance activities necessary for each management unit, based on existing resources.
- The NRMP will provide cost estimates per activity for each management unit.
- The NRMP will include a NAP designation, or similar, for eligible management units.

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- The NRMP will identify target, or desired, natural community type(s) for all management units identified for restoration.
- Any geographic data created by a contractor for the project will be provided in ESRI compatible; State Plane, Survey Foot georeferenced dataset.
- Progress reports will follow established FCPA procedures.

Project Deliverables

- 1. Quarterly progress reports submitted by the NRB.
- 2. A completed NRMP that will include recommendations for a NAP, or suitable equivalent; and identified management units in need of ecological restoration.
- 3. A hydrology study to determine feasibility of restoring hydric natural vegetation communities at targeted areas of the park.
- 4. Final report and/or geographic data for each planning-level ecological survey.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Funding in the amount of \$1,000,000 is currently available in PR-000093, Land Acquisition and Stewardship-2012, Natural Capital Renovation/Natural Resource Management in Fund 30400, Park Bond Construction Fund.


