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ACTION

Scope Approval – Frog Branch Stream Valley Trail Replacement (Sully District)

ISSUE:

Approval of the project scope to design and replace 850 linear feet of a four-foot wide asphalt trail and one culvert in the Frog Branch Stream Valley Park.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Park Authority Executive Director recommends approval of the project scope to design and replace 850 linear feet of a four-foot wide asphalt trail and one culvert in the Frog Branch Stream Valley.

TIMING:

Board action is requested on July 26, 2017 to maintain the project schedule.

BACKGROUND:

The Park Authority Board approved a list of trail projects for funding by the 2012 Park Bond Program on October 23, 2013. That trail project list includes a project to design and replace 850 linear feet of a four-foot wide asphalt trail and one culvert in the Frog Branch Stream Valley Park located behind the Brookfield Swim Club in the Sully District. This project consists of the demolition of the four-foot wide asphalt trail and reconstruction of approximately 850 linear feet of six-foot wide asphalt trail and one culvert.

The referenced section of trail (Attachment 1) has been identified by the Planning and Development Trail Program Manager and Park Operations staff for replacement due to the trail's failing surface condition, which has been impacted by tree roots, uphill concentrated stream flow from storm outfalls, and general deterioration due to life expectancy within a stream valley. One large culvert which conveys stormwater flows from under the trail from the Brookfield Swim Club parking lot has entirely rusted through.

Upon evaluation of the trail condition the project team recommended the four-foot wide trail be replaced with a six-foot width to facilitate maintenance access and construction equipment efficiencies, including replacement of the culvert. Access to this section of trail is limited, and because there is no developed trail connection from Pennsboro Drive

for easy construction access, staff requested and gained approval from the Brookfield Swim Club access the trail from their property just east of their parking lot as a temporary construction entrance. This turf access route will be reclaimed upon the project's completion.

The scope of work for this project includes:

- Design of 850 linear feet of six-foot wide asphalt trail
- Design of pipe culvert to improve trail drainage
- Implementation of invasive plant management
- Demolition of the existing trail
- Trail construction
- Installation of new culvert

The detailed cost estimate for the design of trail improvements as outlined above is \$120,000 (Attachment 2). Staff estimates that the annual maintenance cost of the rehabilitated segment of Frog Branch Stream Valley Trail will increase by \$68.

The proposed timeline for the project is as follows:

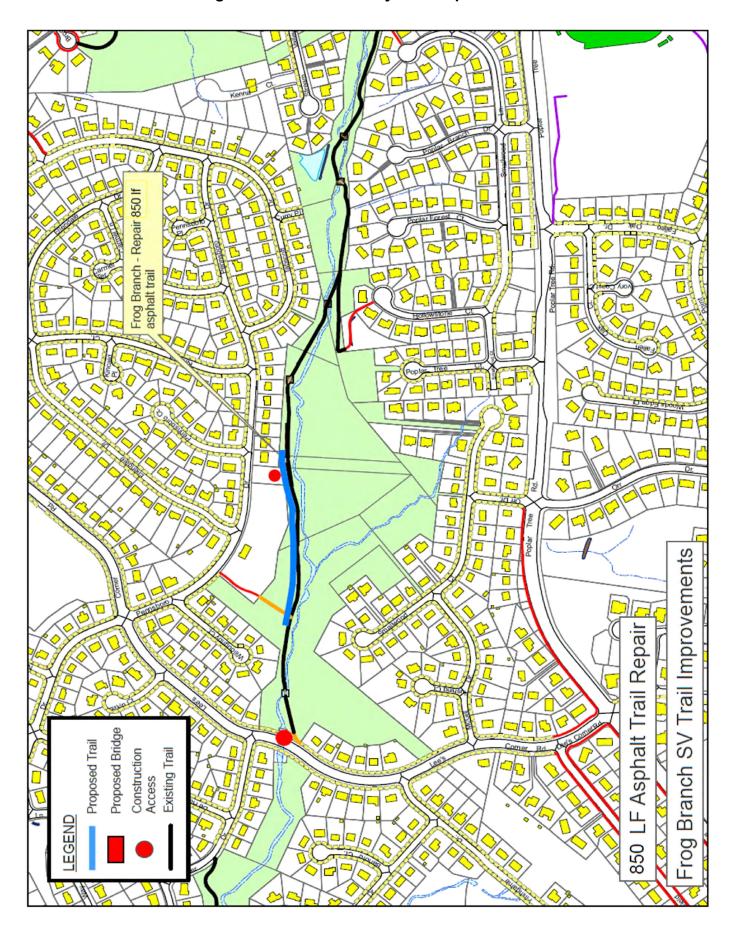
Based on the scope cost estimate, funding in the amount of \$120,000 is necessary for design and construction of this project. Funding is currently available in the amount of \$120,000 in WBS/IO PR-000091-041, Frog Branch Stream Valley Trail Improvements, in Fund 300-C30400, 2012 Park Bond.

<u>Scope Approval – Pinecrest Golf Course Clubhouse – Indoor Golf Practice Facility Renovations and Reallocation of Project Funding (Mason District)</u>

ISSUE:

Approval of the project scope to renovate the existing indoor golf practice facility at the Pinecrest Golf Course Clubhouse and reallocate funding for the project.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Park Authority Executive Director recommends approval of the project scope to renovate the indoor golf practice facility at the Pinecrest Golf Course Clubhouse and reallocate funding for the project.

TIMING:

Board action is requested on July 26, 2017, to maintain the project schedule.

BACKGROUND:

Pinecrest Golf Course is a 57-acre facility located in the Mason District at the corner of Little River Turnpike and Braddock Road in Annandale (Attachment 1). Facilities include off-street parking, clubhouse with indoor practice area, outdoor practice cages, and a 9-hole executive golf course.

The golf course and clubhouse were constructed in 1986. The original clubhouse construction included shell construction for an indoor practice area. A state-of-the art video golf practice system, Golf-O-Mat, was installed in the shell space in 1988 for use as an indoor practice facility. The Golf-O-Mat system is long since out of date and staff desires to renovate the indoor practice facility to meet modern standards.

A project team that includes representatives from the Golf Enterprises, Park Operations and Planning and Development Divisions was assembled to determine the project scope. The architectural and engineering firm of Shaffer, Wilson, Sarver and Gray (SWSG) was hired to prepare a conceptual plan and preliminary cost estimate for improvements to the indoor practice area based on input from the project team. The project team recommends the following scope of work as depicted on the Concept Plan prepared by SWSG (Attachment 2):

- Removal of all interior finishing
- Installation of insulation on all exterior walls and ceiling
- Install new teaching bay suitable for electronic swing analysis
- Furnish and install a Trackman Indoor Golf Simulator
- Install a new HVAC system
- Build-out new hitting bays
- Install new lighting
- Install new windows and skylights
- Build-out a golf office suitable for two staff members with computers

The cost estimate to design, permit, and renovate the indoor practice facility at Pinecrest Golf Course is \$448,400 (Attachment 3).

Staff estimates the renovation of the indoor practice facility will result in additional net annual revenue of \$26,150 in the first full year of operation and increasing to \$44,375 by the third year of operation. Staff estimates an increase in annual operating and maintenance costs in the amount of \$1,200 with a lifecycle cost of \$30,000 for systems replacements in 15 years.

The proposed timeline for completing the project is as follows:

Funding in the amount of \$100,000 was approved for the project as part of the allocation of funds from the Revenue Facilities Capital Sinking Fund in March 2016. Additional funding in the amount of \$30,000 is available in the General County Construction Fund and \$24,400 via a donation to the Park Foundation with a \$20,000 matching Mastenbrook Grant for a total available funding of \$174,400. Additional funding in the amount of \$274,000 is required to fund the scope of the project based on the scope cost estimate. Staff recommends reallocating funding in the amount of \$196,306 from the unexpended balance in the completed Pinecrest Golf Course Stream Restoration Project in the 2008 Park Bond and \$77,694 from the available balance of completed projects that were funded as part of the allocation of 2008 Park Bond bond premium funds in February of 2016.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Based on the scope cost estimate, funding in the amount of \$448,400 is required to fund this project. Funding in the amount of \$100,000 is currently available in Project

PR-000101-004, Pinecrest Golf Course Indoor Driving Range, Fund 80300 Park Improvement Fund; funding in the amount of \$77,694 is currently available in Project PR-000005, Park and Building Renovation-2008; funding in the amount of \$196,306 is currently available in Project PR-000012, Stewardship-2008; funding in the amount of \$20,000 is currently available in Project PR-000009, Community Parks/New Facilities-2012, all in Fund 30400 Park Authority Bond Construction; funding in the amount of \$30,000 is available in Fund 30010, General County Construction; and funding in the amount of \$24,400 is currently available from the Park Foundation for a total of \$448,000.

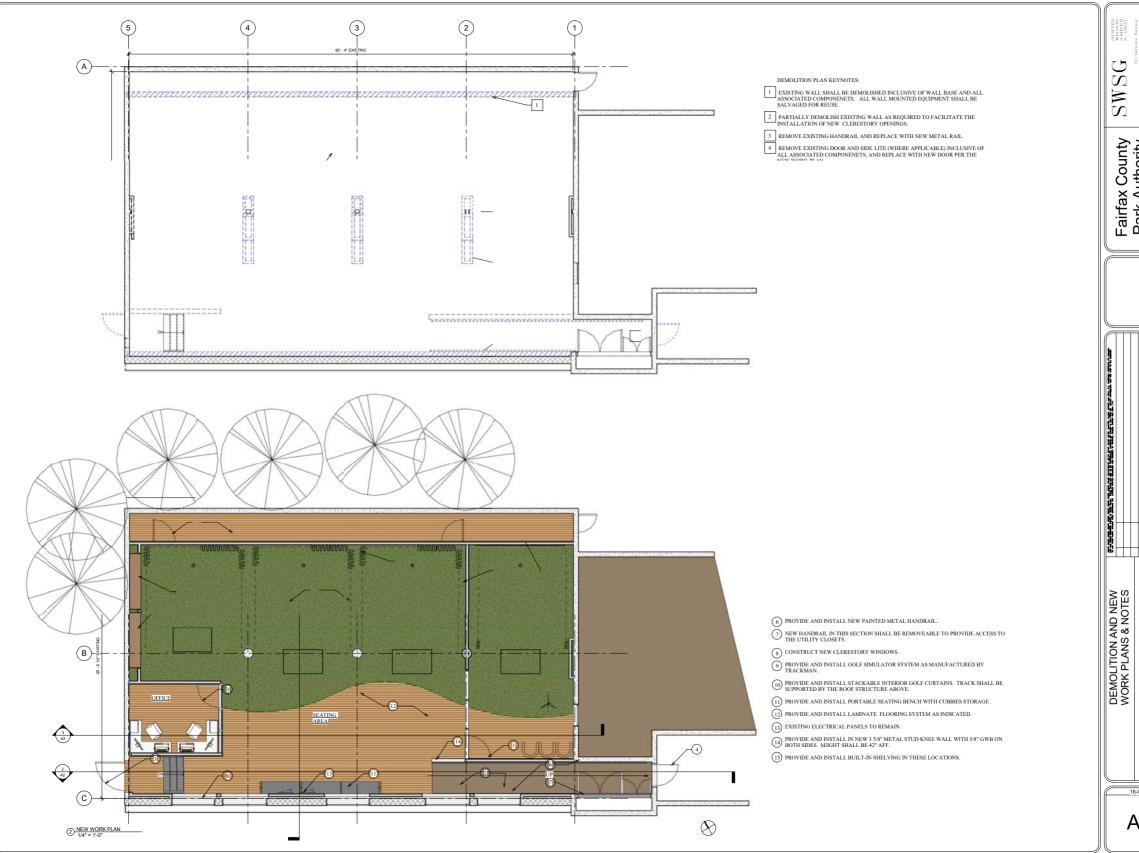

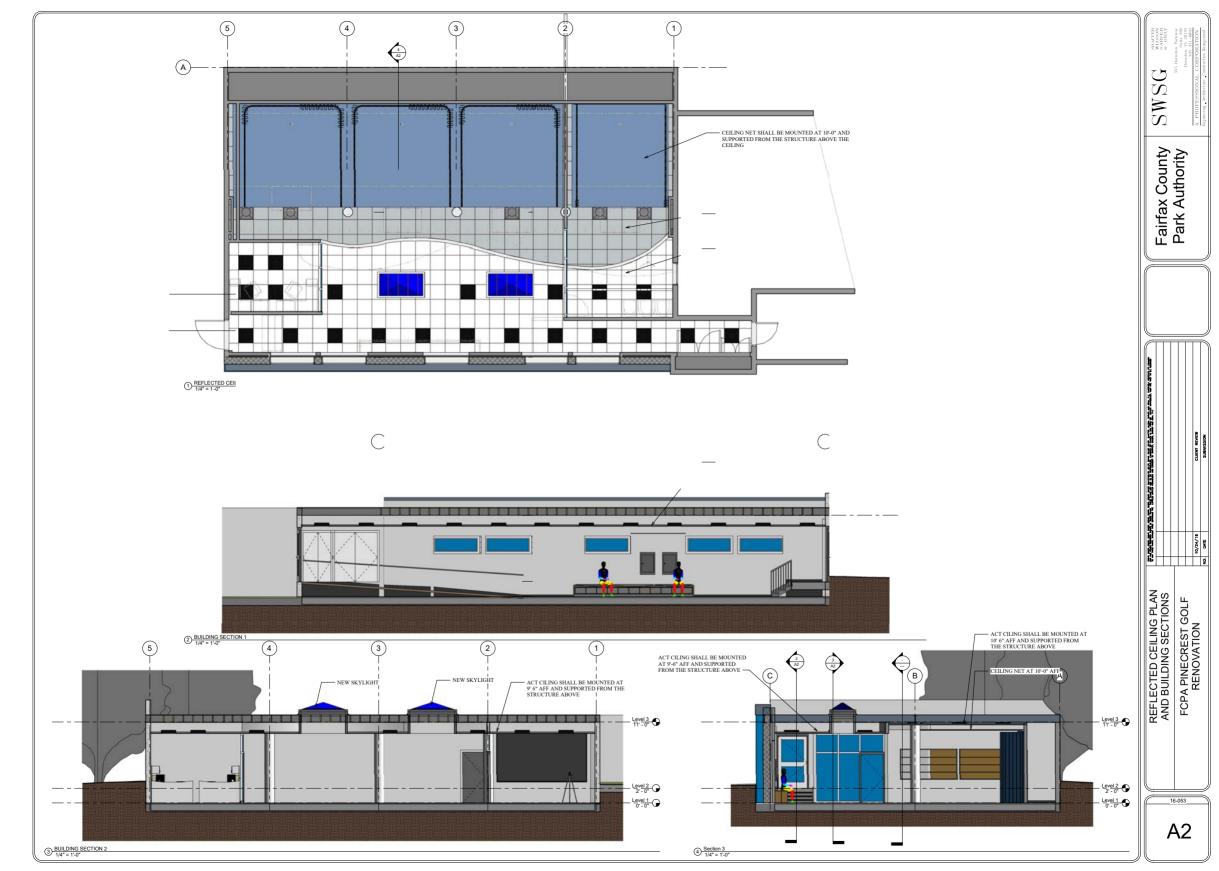

<u>Scope Approval – Colvin Run Miller's House Programmatic Building Renovations</u> (<u>Dranesville District</u>)

ISSUE:

Approval of the project scope for programmatic building renovations for staff and public use of the Colvin Run Miller's House.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Park Authority Executive Director recommends approval of the project scope for programmatic building renovations for staff and public use of the Colvin Run Miller's House.

TIMING:

Board action is requested on July 26, 2017, to maintain the project schedule.

BACKGROUND:

Colvin Run Mill is a 56-acre historic site located in the Dranesville District. The site includes a mill, Miller's House, general store, carriage shed/barn, and parking lot (Attachment 1). The site preserves and interprets the historic buildings for the enrichment of Fairfax County residents, and is listed on the National Register of Historic Places.

The Park Authority Board approved revisions to the Colvin Run Mill Historic Site Master Plan that emphasized the need to identify, record, and preserve the park's cultural resources and foster attitudes and practices that support conservation of cultural resources on September 24, 2008. The Master Plan's Conceptual Development Plan identified the core interpretive zone elements that include the mill, Miller's House, general store and blacksmith shop. Due to funding restraints, the Miller's House portion of the Master Plan was divided into two phases.

The first phase funded by the 2012 Park Bond to structurally stabilize the Miller's House and preserve the exterior/envelope of the house to improve its thermal and moisture properties was completed in June 2017.

The second phase consists of renovating the interior upstairs office area, such as replacing existing carpeting and painting, adding IT Infrastructure upstairs to support

staff computers, upgrading security due to the added collections on display, and enhancing the downstairs of the Miller's House with period significant interpretive exhibits for public viewing.

The 2016 Park Bond and the FY 2018 Planning and Development Division Work Plan includes the second phase of the project of the Miller's House stabilization for programmatic renovations. A project team that includes representatives from the Resource Management, Park Services, Park Operations and Planning and Development Divisions was assembled to determine the project scope. The project team recommends the following scope of work:

- Interior Office Renovation (Upstairs)
- Infrastructure IT
- Security Upgrade
- Interpretive Exhibits

The cost estimate for completing the recommended scope of work is \$272,000 (Attachment 2).

The proposed timeline for completing the project is as follows:

<u>Phase</u> <u>Start</u> <u>Complete</u>

Construction Third Quarter CY17 First Quarter CY18

Staff estimates the programmatic building renovations will result in additional annual revenue of \$500. Staff estimates an increase in annual operating and maintenance costs in the amount of \$200 with a lifecycle cost of \$150,000 for systems replacements in year 20.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Based on the scope cost estimate, funding in the amount of \$272,000 is necessary to fund this project. Funding is currently available in the amount of \$272,000 in Project PR-000076-002, Colvin Run Miller's House Phase 2 in Fund 30400, 2016 Park Authority Bond Construction.

<u>Scope Approval – Construction of Picnic Shelters at Lee District Park Family Recreation Area (Lee District)</u>

ISSUE:

Approval of the project scope to construct picnic shelters at the Family Recreation Area at Lee District Park.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Park Authority Executive Director recommends approval of the project scope to construct two picnic shelters at the Family Recreation Area at Lee District Park.

TIMING:

Board action is requested on July 26, 2017, to maintain the project schedule.

BACKGROUND:

The Lee District Park Master Plan, incorporating a Family Recreation Area (FRA), was approved by the Park Authority Board in May 2006. The FRA included an accessible tree house, spray park, restroom building, themed accessible play area, carousel, and picnic shelters. In June 2008 staff requested scope approval of the FRA with phased development based on available funding. Phase I consisted of the treehouse, spray park and restroom and related site improvements. Construction of the initial phase was completed in 2011. Phase II consisted of installation of two themed accessible play areas and construction was completed in 2013. Phase III consisted of the installation of a new accessible carousel which was completed in June 2017. The final phase of development of the FRA includes installation of two picnic shelters.

The Park Authority Board approved the project scope for design and installation of the accessible carousel in June 2016. The approved project scope recommendation included design of two picnic shelters in addition to the carousel to be constructed when funding was available. The 2016 Park Bond included funding for a project to construct the picnic shelters.

A project team comprised of representatives from Resource Management, Park Services, Park Operations, and Planning and Development Divisions was assembled in 2016 to determine the scope of work for development of the accessible carousel and picnic shelters. The civil engineering firm of Bowman Consulting Group completed the

design for the installation of the carousel and picnic shelters in 2016 based on input from the project team. The project team recommends proceeding with the following scope of work for construction of the picnic shelters as designed by Bowman Consulting Group (Attachment 1):

- Permit and construct two 25' diameter accessible picnic shelters on concrete pads including tie-in to existing accessible walkways.
- Provide picnic tables and other furnishings.

The estimated cost to permit and construct the picnic shelters and provide picnic tables and furnishings as outlined above is \$520,000 (Attachment 2).

Staff estimates the addition of the picnic shelters will result in additional annual revenue of \$13,730. Staff estimates an increase in annual maintenance costs in the amount of \$3,332 with a lifecycle cost of \$6,000 in year twenty for renovation of the steel structures and a lifecycle cost of \$7,500 in year thirty for roof replacements for the picnic shelters.

The proposed timeline for the project is as follows:

FISCAL IMPACT:

Based on the scope cost estimate, funding in the amount of \$520,000 is required to permit and construct this project. Funding is currently available in the PR-000079-003, Lee District Family Recreation Area-Picnic Shelters in Fund 300-C30400 2016 Park Bond Construction Fund.

<u>Approval – Naming of Mason District Park Diamond Field #1 in Honor of Ivan "Pudge"</u> <u>Rodriguez as part of Washington Nationals Dream Foundation Turnkey Donation of</u> <u>Field Improvements (Mason District)</u>

ISSUE:

Approval of naming of Mason District Park Diamond Field #1 in honor of Ivan "Pudge" Rodriguez as part of the Washington Nationals Dream Foundation turnkey donation of field improvements.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Park Authority Executive Director recommends approval of naming Mason District Park Diamond Field #1 in honor of Ivan "Pudge" Rodriguez as part of the Washington Nationals Dream Foundation turnkey donation of field improvements.

TIMING:

Board approval of the field naming is requested on July 12, 2017, for a planned ribbon cutting ceremony on August 28, 2017.

BACKGROUND:

Mason District Little League (MDLL), the primary user of diamond field #1 at Mason District Park, has been adopted by the Washington Nationals Baseball Club for the 2017 season. The Washington Nationals Baseball Club has an initiative to renovate local baseball fields via the Washington Nationals Dream Foundation's (WNDF), a non-profit 501(c)3 charitable organization with a charitable initiative to renovate youth baseball fields through its "Legacy Fields" program. The Park Authority Board approved a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the Washington Nationals Dream Foundation for a turnkey donation of field improvements at Mason District Park diamond field #1 on May 24, 2017.

The MOA includes that subject to FCPA Policy 307 - Sponsorship and the approval process set forth therein, WNDF may name the field as part of the project, including, without limitation, after a current or former player, coach or executive of the Washington Nationals franchise. The field name shall be included on the scoreboard, monument, and any directional signage per the MOA. WNDF desires to name the Field "Iván 'Pudge' Rodríguez Field" in honor of Rodríguez's baseball career and community

service in the Washington, DC metropolitan area. Mr. Rodriguez's distinguished playing career spanned 21 major league baseball seasons from 1991 through 2011. Mr. Rodriguez played his last two seasons with Washington Nationals before retiring from baseball in 2011. He will be inducted into the Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown, New York, on July 30, 2017, after being selected in his first year of eligibility.

WNDF is entering into a license agreement with Mr. Rodriguez to secure the use of his name for the field at Mason District Park (Attachment 1). The Park Authority will be party to the license agreement in accordance with the naming rights requirements included in Policy 307. The term of the naming rights will run concurrently with the initial ten-year term of the MOA and may be renewed as part of the renewal of the MOA after expiration of the initial term. The license agreement stipulates that Mr. Rodríguez agrees that WNDF and the Park Authority may use his name and likeness in connection with the field free of any fee, including but not limited to, any royalties. WNDF is assuming all costs for providing the scoreboard and monument sign recognizing the field as, "Iván 'Pudge' Rodríguez Field", in accordance with the MOA for the field improvements.

A ribbon cutting ceremony in conjunction with completion of the field improvements is scheduled for August 28, 2017. WNDF is hoping to have Mr. Rodriguez attend the ribbon cutting to celebrate naming the field in his honor.

License Agreement

This License Agreement ("Agreement") is made effective as of [], 2017 ("Effective Date") by and among Ivan Rodriguez ("Rodriguez"), the Washington Nationals Dream Foundation ("WNDF"), and the Fairfax County Park Authority ("FCPA").

Recitals

WHEREAS, WNDF and FCPA are parties to the Memorandum of Agreement executed on or about June 11, 2017 (the "MOA") whereby WNDF agreed to cause a general contractor to renovate certain elements of Field #1 at Mason District Park (the "Field") as part of WNDF's "Legacy Fields" program; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the MOA and FCPA Policy 307, WNDF desires to name the Field "Iván 'Pudge' Rodríguez Field" in honor of Rodríguez's baseball career and community service in the Washington, DC metropolitan area.

WHEREAS, Rodríguez desires to allow WNDF and the FCPA to use his name and likeness free of charge in connection with the Field.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the terms and conditions of this Agreement, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. Recitals. The "Recitals" set forth above are incorporated into this Agreement.
- 2. Term. The term ("Term") of this Agreement shall be coterminous with the MOA.
- 3. <u>Naming of the Field.</u> From and after the Effective Date of this Agreement, the parties agree that the Field shall be called "Iván 'Pudge' Rodríguez Field". The scoreboard and monument at the Field, and any related directional signage shall include this name. Preliminary drawings of the scoreboard and monument are attached as Exhibit A.
- 4. <u>Grant of License</u>. For the Term of this Agreement and subject to its terms and conditions, Rodriguez hereby grants FCPA and WNDF a limited, royalty-free, non-exclusive license to use his name, image, and/or likeness: (i) to name the Field, the scoreboard, the monument, and any related directional signage; (ii) to refer to the Field, including, without limitation, verbally, in any documentation or in any press releases; and (iii) on the scoreboard.
- 5. <u>Representations and Warranties.</u> Rodriguez represents and warrants that he possesses all rights, title, interest, and privilege required to grant the license provided in this Agreement.
- 6. <u>Fee.</u> Rodríguez agrees that WNDF and FCPA may use his name and likeness in connection with the Field free of any fee, including but not limited to, any royalties.
- 7. <u>Removal of Name.</u> FCPA shall notify all the parties to this Agreement in writing if it removes the naming of the Field pursuant to FCPA Policy 307 attached as Exhibit B.

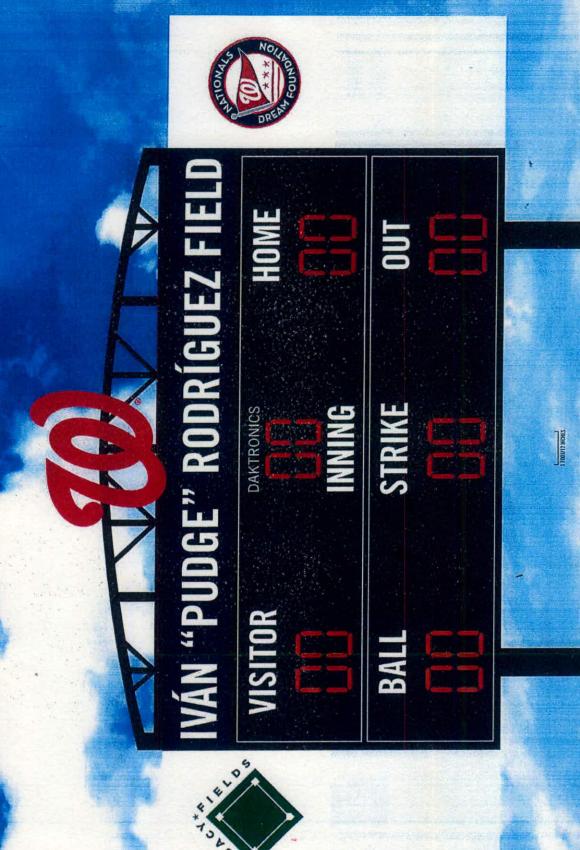
- 8. Termination. Each party shall have the right to terminate this Agreement if any other party should breach a material term of this Agreement and such breach affects the party initiating termination, and which the breaching party does not cure within thirty (30) days of receipt of written notice of the breach. Upon the expiration or termination of this Agreement all licenses granted herein shall immediately terminate. In the event this Agreement is terminated by Rodriguez: (i) WNDF shall rename the Field subject to Section 8 of the MOA; (ii) WNDF shall bear all costs to change and update the scoreboard and monument; and (iii) FCPA shall bear all costs to update directional signage. In addition, FCPA reserves the right to terminate this Agreement if conditions arise during the term of the Agreement that result in it conflicting with FCPA Policy 307 or if this Agreement no longer supports the best interests of the FCPA.
- 9. <u>Miscellaneous</u>. All notices shall be in writing, and shall be deemed delivered 3 days after deposit in the U.S. mail, certified, return receipt requested, to the addresses below and in the case of WNDF, with a copy sent to its Legal Department. The parties are independent contractors. This Agreement shall be governed by the internal laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia. If any provision of this Agreement is declared invalid or unenforceable by an arbitrator or court of competent jurisdiction, such provision shall be severed from the remainder of this Agreement, which shall remain in full force and effect. This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties regarding its subject matter and may not be amended except by a writing signed by an authorized representative of each party. This Agreement may be executed in any number of counterparts (including by facsimile or .pdf), each of which will be deemed an original, but all of which taken together shall constitute one single agreement.

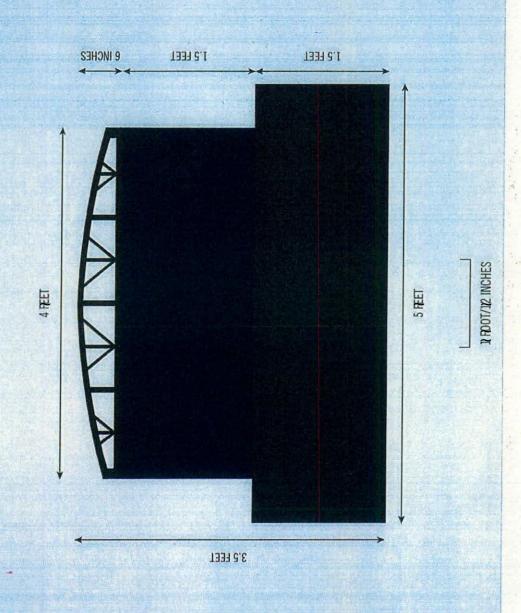

Policy 307 Title: Sponsorship							
Date Approved: 6/22/2016	Last reviewed: N/A						
Objective: Implement FCPA Policy on Sponsorships							

Purpose: To establish guidelines that govern the approval of sponsorship agreements involving Park Authority assets.

Policy Statement: It is the policy of the Park Authority to actively seek sponsorships from corporations, nonprofit organizations and other entities for its events, programs, facilities, parks and planned facility improvements. The purpose of such sponsorships is to create mutually beneficial partnerships that help the Park Authority to achieve the following objectives:

- 1. generate revenue streams to support the Park Authority in furthering its mission;
- expand or improve Park Authority service delivery;
- 3. encourage and enhance the public's use and enjoyment of the FCPA system;
- 4. establish partnerships which promote and elevate the Park Authority's brand and create relevant, authentic and compelling associations.

Distinction between Sponsorships and Donations or Partnerships

This policy relates only to sponsorship and not to other fundraising, donations, or partnership activities, which are addressed by Policy 406 Fundraising and Policy 407 Partnerships respectively. For purposes of this policy, a sponsorship is a mutually beneficial exchange between the Park Authority and the sponsoring entity where the sponsor contributes cash or in-kind products and services in exchange for benefits of commensurate value that help it achieve marketing objectives. Donations may be designated for a purpose, but are without detailed restrictions or expected benefits in exchange for the gifting of financial or in-kind resources. Partnerships may confer a benefit on the partnering entity, but do not necessarily aid in achieving marketing objectives.

General Guidelines for Sponsorships

Acceptable sponsorships must meet the following criteria:

- 1. All sponsorships must be compatible with the Park Authority mission.
- 2. Sponsorship benefits will not impact the park users' experience or overly commercialize the park environment. Sponsorship benefits will comply with Park Authority design standards, facility aesthetics and visitor experience in the setting in which they are placed.



- 3. Sponsorships benefits provided by the Park Authority will not exceed the value of sponsorship benefits received.
- 4. Sponsorships cannot be made conditional on Park Authority performance outcomes.

The following types of sponsors/sponsorships are not acceptable.

- 1. Political candidates, political parties or other entities whose primary purpose in engaging in sponsorship is non-commercial speech.
- 2. Tobacco products.
- 3. Alcoholic beverages, except where approved by the Park Authority Board.
- 4. Sexually explicit materials or businesses and other goods/businesses/services inappropriate for promotion to a family audience.
- 5. Entities that practice or promote discrimination on the basis of race, color, sex, creed, religion, national origin, age, disability, genetic information, veterans' status or disabled veterans' status.
- 6. Entities that promote practices that if they took place in the county would violate U.S. or state law.
- 7. Any other sponsor inconsistent with the mission of the Park Authority or Fairfax County Government.

General Provisions for Sponsor Recognition

- 1. Sponsorship benefits will be provided pursuant to a Sponsorship Agreement between the Park Authority and the Sponsor.
- 2. The Park Authority will work with the Sponsor in creating the sponsorship benefits. The Park Authority retains final approval over the content, placement, appearance, and wording of all benefits provided to sponsors. Any physical form of on-site recognition will be done in a way that minimizes impacts on the park user's experience and park operations.
- 3. The Park Authority must approve in writing the use of its logos and all other marketing associations by Sponsors for their use. All such uses by the Sponsor



must be associated with the specific sponsorship and are prohibited for any other use.

- 4. Sponsorship does not imply endorsement of the sponsor or its goods or services by the Park Authority or the County.
- 5. A sponsorship agreement shall not confer on any sponsoring entity an enforceable right, entitlement, or other property interest of any sort relating to the use, possession or control of any Park Authority assets, except as to a limited and non-exclusive right to use Park Authority logos/marketing associations or other intellectual property which may be authorized in the sponsorship agreement.
- 6. A sponsorship agreement shall not confer on any sponsoring entity the power to direct or control management and operation of any Park Authority facility or program or otherwise limit the discretion to operate a Park Authority facility or program in a manner that comports with applicable laws, best practices or the Park Authority's best interests.

Administration and Approval

The process for obtaining sponsorships shall be administered by the Fairfax County Park Authority in coordination with Park Foundation staff. The Park Authority is authorized to enter into negotiation with prospective sponsors for park assets deemed eligible by agreement of the Park Authority and Park Foundation.

Sponsorships shall require an approved sponsorship agreement that contains the following:

- Details of the exchange of benefits, including a description of all fees, products, services, in-kind services or other benefits provided to the Park Authority by the sponsor, and all marketing rights and benefits provided by the Park Authority to the sponsor.
- 2. Term of the agreement and termination provisions.
- 3. Signatures by authorized representatives of the Park Authority and the sponsor.

The level of approval required for sponsorship agreements is based on the amount and complexity of benefits exchanged. Approval includes evaluation by legal counsel of the sponsorship agreement for compliance with applicable federal and state tax laws. Park Authority Board approval is required for sponsorships in which the Park Authority receives benefits valued at \$100,000 or greater. Sponsorships with a value under \$100,000 are approved by the Park Authority Director or designee.



Naming Rights

Temporary naming rights may be conferred as one form of a sponsorship benefit for events, programs, parks, buildings (existing or planned) or facilities (existing or planned). Naming rights granted for events or programs are a short-term benefit, existing only for the duration of the program, while naming rights for parks, buildings or facilities are of longer duration. This section of the policy provides the following additional guidance for temporary naming rights granted as a sponsorship benefit for parks, buildings or facilities.

- 1. A temporary naming right may be granted for parks, buildings or facilities provided the fiscal benefit derived by the Park Authority is commensurate with the value of the specific park asset involved.
- 2. All naming rights agreements for parks, buildings or facilities must be approved by the Park Authority Board.
- 3. The duration of temporary naming rights for parks, buildings or facilities shall not be less than five years.
- 4. Names assigned to parks, buildings or facilities under a temporary naming right agreement should normally be the shortest name possible, and should incorporate the current Park Authority recorded name.

Terminating Sponsorships

The Park Authority reserves the right to terminate an existing sponsorship agreement should conditions arise during the term of the sponsorship that result in it conflicting with this policy or if that sponsorship no longer supports the best interests of the Park Authority. A decision to terminate shall be made by the Director or the Park Authority Board in accordance with the approval levels described in this policy, in consultation with the County Attorney.

Planning and Development Division Annual Work Plan Schedule for FY 2018

ISSUE:

Approval of the Planning and Development Division Annual Work Plan for FY 2018.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Park Authority Executive Director recommends approval of the Planning and Development Division Annual Work Plan for FY 2018.

TIMING:

Board action is requested on July 26, 2017, so that priority projects can be incorporated into the Planning and Development Work Plan and initiated in FY 2018 to meet the proposed project schedules.

BACKGROUND:

The Planning and Development Division's FY 2017 Work Plan was approved by the Park Authority Board on July 27, 2016. Projects funded by the 2008 and 2012 Park Bond Programs included in the FY 2017 Work Plan have generally been proceeding on or ahead of schedule. The Park Authority Board approved the five-year Park Capital Improvement Program (CIP) for FY 2018 – FY 2022 Including Out-Years to 2024 on May 24, 2017, which incorporates projects included in the 2016 Park Bond. The FY 2018 – FY 2022 CIP includes planned schedules for the projects included in the Park Bonds based on guidance received from the County Executive and the Department of Management and Budget (DMB) as required to meet the county's overall Capital Improvement Program goals and DMB's financial management strategy for the sale of general obligation bonds based on the current budget outlook through FY 2022.

Staff presented the proposed FY 2018 Planning and Development Division Work Plan to the Board for consideration at the Planning and Development Committee meeting on June 14, 2017. The FY 2018 Work Plan reflects the continuation of active projects with schedules that extend into FY 2018 and beyond as well as projects that are scheduled to start in FY 2018 as included in the FY 2018 – FY 2022 CIP. The Plan separates the projects into seven categories:

Planning projects

- Projects funded via proffers; projects funded via partnership/donation; projects funded via the General County Construction Fund; and projects funded via the Park Capital Improvement Fund
- Projects funded in the 2008 Park Bond
- Projects funded in the 2012 Park Bond
- Synthetic turf field replacement projects
- Projects funded by the Park Authority's Revenue Sinking Fund as approved by the Park Authority Board in March 2016
- Projects funded by the General County Construction Fund for Infrastructure Replacement and Upgrade as approved as part of FY 2017 Fairfax County Budget

The final FY 2018 Planning and Development Division Work Plan is provided as Attachment 1. Projects highlighted in green are new to the Work Plan and are scheduled to start in FY 2018.

Highlights of the FY 2018 Work Plan include:

- Adoption of the Agency Master Plan
- Scoping for Museum and Archeology Collection Facility
- Lifecycle replacement of synthetic turf on five athletic fields
- Design of Sully Woodlands Stewardship Education Center
- Completion of the Burke Lake Golf Course Club House replacement
- Completion of improvements at Hidden Pond Park.
- Partnership with Washington Nationals and Mason District Little League for improvements to baseball diamond at Mason District Park
- Completion of bunker renovation at Twin Lakes Golf Course Lakes Course Completion of the System-wide RECenter Feasibility Study
- Design of Mount Vernon RECenter Expansion and Renovation
- Design of the Patriot Park North Diamond Athletic Field Complex
- Development of Monticello Park Phase 1 Improvements.
- Life-cycle system replacements/improvements at various parks and RECenters
- Predesign for improvements to Hidden Oaks Nature Center
- Replacement of fitness trail at Nottoway Park
- Infrastructure trail improvements at Chalet Woods Park and Horsepen Run Stream Valley

Staff will also continue to be actively engaged in land acquisition, long range planning, and master planning throughout FY 2018. Staff will continue to report actual project progress compared with the scheduled dates on the Work Plan on a quarterly basis to the Board.
