- A-1 <u>Hooes Road Park Mastenbrook Volunteer Matching Fund Grant Program Request –</u> <u>Springfield South County Youth Club (Lee District)</u> Mr. Hackman made a motion to approve the Mastenbrook Volunteer Matching Fund Grant Program request from the Springfield South County Youth Club in the amount of \$20,000 to help fund the installation of athletic field lighting at Hooes Road Park rectangular field #3; seconded by Mr. Thompson. The motion carried by all members present; Mr. Kendall was absent.
- A-2 Scope Approval and Allocation of Funds Lakes Course Twin Lakes Golf Course Irrigation System Improvements – Phase 2 (Springfield District) Mr. Thompson made a motion to approve the project scope and funding allocation to install the Phase 2 improvements to the irrigation system at the Lakes Course at Twin Lakes Golf Course; seconded by Mr. Quincy. The motion carried by all members present Mr. Kendall was absent.
- A-3 <u>Scope Approval Construction of Pohick Stream Valley Trail Burke Station Park to</u> <u>Hillside Road (Springfield District)</u> Mr. Thompson made a motion to approve the project scope to construct 2,200 linear feet of eight-foot wide asphalt and concrete trail and one stream crossing in the Pohick Stream Valley Park from Burke Station Park to Hillside Road; seconded by Mr. Quincy. • Mr. Bouie reported that he has been having numerous discussions with members of the Board of Supervisors and county staff. The Park Authority will need to acclimate itself to the newly elected members of the Board of Supervisors. He extended congratulations to them and is looking forward to celebrating those members that are leaving at the Elly Doyle Awards ceremony on November 22.

The Park Authority continues to receive maximum exposure from the lesser known pro sports teams in the area. They are all looking for partnership possibilities some between the Caps, Nationals, and Washington Spirit.

- Mr. Kincannon announced that Aimee Vosper was elected to the board of the National Association of County Park and Recreation Officials (NACPRO).
- He reminded everyone that the Holiday party will take place on December 6 at Twin Lakes Golf Course. Invitations are scheduled to go out on Thursday, November 14.
- The Elly Doyle Park Services Awards will take place on Friday, November 22, at the Waterford at Fair Oaks. He reminded everyone to RSVP.

BOARD MATTERS

• Ms. Godbold reported that on the last Saturday in October the Friends of E. C. Lawrence Park met. She thanked John Shafer and Eric Inman for presentation on the progress of the Sully Woodlands Education Center. She is very excited about the Friends Group.

Ms. Godbold asked if PIO needed to know who would be attending the Board of Supervisors' meeting on December 3. Ms. Pedersen indicated it was not necessary.

- Mr. Hackman thanked Parks for the naming of the barn at Colvin Run Mill in honor of Bob and Marjorie Lundegard. It was a beautiful and moving event. The family was very touched. The Lundegards volunteered over 25,000 hours and are national scholars in terms of historic sites. He thanked Judy Pedersen and everyone that participated.
- He noted that at his request Ms. Gorski forwarded an email from McLean Citizens Association (MCA) to the board. A message and resolution adopted by MCA was sent to the Supervisors Foust and Smyth, the County Executive, and CFO which noted the roughly \$156 million of unfunded critical repairs, unfunded capital needs, less per capita spending on parks and recreation per capital and per actively managed acre than surrounding communities and national averages. MCA also recommended serious consideration of a \$200 million Park Authority bond on the 2020 ballot.
- No other board members had matters to bring forward.
