RENOVATION STATUS REPORT

Winter 2024

On Dec. 31, 2022, the Mount Vernon Rec Center closed its doors in preparation for a major

renovation and expansion expected to last two years. The project will include a complete renovation of the current building, updates to the mechanical systems and expansion. When complete, the state-of-the-art facility will include two NHL-sized ice rinks, a two-level dedicated fitness area, an elevated indoor track, swimming pool, climbing wall and multi-purpose rooms. Anticipated completion is scheduled in the spring of 2025.



Project Update:

Construction progress remains on schedule for the Rec Center's renovation and expansion. Steel is being installed in the expanded, two-level fitness area, and will soon be erected for the second rink. January's weather has been a challenge for the contractor, with a mix of extreme cold, periodic heavy rain and accumulating snow, but the contractor has remained focused and adjusted their crews as necessary to maintain schedule.
