Authorization to Advertise a Public Hearing to Establish Parking Restrictions on Lee Jackson Memorial Highway Service Road (Sully District)

The Board authorized advertisement of a public hearing for October 24, 2017 at 4:00 p.m. to consider adoption of the Fairfax County Code amendment to Appendix R, to prohibit commercial vehicles, recreational vehicles and trailers as defined, respectively, in Fairfax County Code §§ 82-5-7, 82-5B-1, and 82-1-2(a)(50), from parking on the south side of Lee Jackson Memorial Highway service road, from Chantilly Road to Galesbury Lane, from 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 a.m., seven days a week.
