

# Recycling Rate 1999-2018


**Annual Recycling Rate Fairfax County**






# Yard Waste

# Ending Curbside Recycling

### Benefits


- Decreased system-wide collection costs
- Decreased traffic
- Decreased vehicle emissions

### Drawbacks

- Loss of recyclable resources
- Loss of environmental service for the community
- Faster consumption of landfill space (ash)

### Cost Comparison

 Material Recovery Facility \$49/ton vs Covanta \$36/ton





# Ending Curbside Yard Waste

Benefits

- Decreased system-wide collection costs
- Decreased traffic
- Decreased vehicle emissions

### Drawbacks

- 100% recyclable material
- Loss of free landscape materials for residents
- Faster consumption of landfill space (ash)

### **Cost Comparison**

 Compost Facility \$36/ton vs Covanta \$36/ton






# Conclusions and Recommendations
