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#### FAIRFAX PIVOT GRANT PROGRAM

- Board of Supervisors established on June 8, 2021
- Program Purpose
  - ➤ Help the most negatively impacted small businesses and nonprofit organizations remain in business and retain employees.
  - ➤ Sustain business sectors which employ disproportionately higher numbers of low-income and minority workers.
  - Assist impacted small businesses and nonprofits by mitigating financial hardship.
- Program funded with up to \$25,000,000 for grants, which do not need to be repaid by grantees.

#### **Small business and nonprofit sectors:**

- 1. Food Services (including Food Trucks)
- 2. Lodging (hotels)
- 3. Retail, Services, and Amusements
- 4. Art Organizations, Museums, Historical Sites





## **PIVOT GRANT APPLICATION: PHASE 1**

Grant application period open June 23-July 9

Phase I: Through online application portal, applicants asked a series of questions to determine initial eligibility.

1,597 Eligible Applicants
Funding Requested: \$24,440,500
Lottery not required



Phase I Applicants reported:

- 46% reduction in revenue between 2019 and 2020 on average.
- 25% reduction number of employees between 2019 and 2020 on average.

#### **INELIGIBLE APPLICATIONS**

#### 921 applicants did not meet eligibility criteria

Most frequently reported reasons:

- 533 did not meet threshold for economic Injury
- 311 did not have a commercial storefront
- 172 secured an SBA Restaurant Revitalization Fund grant

#### **PIVOT GRANT APPLICATION PROCESS**

#### The application consists of three phases:

Phase 1: Initial Eligibility Check

Phase 2: Submission of required documentation

Phase 3: Submission of eligible expense invoices
