Subject: Expiration of VPDES Construction General Permit on June 30, 2019

Date: March 26, 2019

Summary: The General Virginia Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (VPDES) Permit for Discharges of Stormwater from Construction Activities (Construction General Permit) will expire on June 30, 2019.

Effective Date: Immediately.

Background: This notice is to remind all operators that have an active Construction General Permit (CGP) that it will expire on June 30, 2019. Virginia Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) is actively developing the 2019 permit and expects to finalize it in Spring 2019. If you operate construction activities under the existing CGP and will continue land-disturbing activities after June 30, 2019, or if you have not achieved final stabilization, then you must reapply for coverage under the new permit.

Unless you have achieved final stabilization, you must submit a complete [2019 Registration Statement](#) by **May 1, 2019**. There is **no fee** associated with the reissuance of permit coverage. Furthermore, DEQ will administratively continue your coverage under the 2014 permit if you submit a complete registration statement to Fairfax County by the required date. If final stabilization has been achieved, you must submit a [Notice of Termination](#).
