SWA 21-003 –Eliminating Waste Delivery/Disposal Agreement

The purpose of this Solid Waste Advisory (SWA) is to provide guidance to licensed solid waste collectors concerning the elimination of the Waste Delivery/Disposal Agreement. The Fairfax County Solid Waste Management Program (SWMP) made modifications to our program that improves equity for all companies and streamlines the renewal application process. These changes eliminate administrative paperwork and makes business easier for many companies as they work with us throughout the year.

Companies will agree to the required conditions found in the Application under Permit Application-Required Conditions for issuance of the Permit and abide by all conditions. The Permit Application-Required Conditions have been extracted from the Waste Delivery/Disposal Agreement.
