SWA 20-008 – Access Road Restrictions at the I-95 Complex

This is a reminder that all commercial vehicles conducting business at the I-95 Landfill Complex (including the Covanta facility) must access the site via the intersection of U.S. Route 1 and Furnace Road, proceeding north towards the complex via the access road at Mordor Drive.

Commercial vehicles **must exit the Complex using this same route**. Trucks are also prohibited from using Lorton Road.

Violators will be subject to the penalty rate (\$100/ton) for disposal **each time** a County employee witnesses entry to or exit from any road other than the access road at Mordor Drive.

This is the ninth in a series of Solid Waste Advisories being distributed to the County's solid waste industry during the COVID-19 emergency. Collectors are advised to closely review these Advisories upon receipt, and to share their contents with customers as appropriate.
