SWA 22-004 Required Use of Personal Protective Equipment at I-66 Transfer Station

Effective September 1, 2022, all commercial users of the I-66 Transfer Station must wear a hard hat, safety glasses, safety vest, gloves, and safety shoes to be allowed **outside of their vehicle on the tipping floor**.

Collectors are also reminded that the use of cell phones is prohibited on the tipping floor, collector employees must maintain at least a 15-foot distance from other vehicles and heavy equipment while at the Transfer Station and scavenging anything from discharged waste at the site is expressly prohibited.
