

Suspended Operator's License Interview (Intervention Interview)

1. What is Driving Suspended Program?

It is a service Fairfax - ASAP provides for DMV. It has nothing to do with an alcohol or drug charge.

This program is made available to persons charged with driving suspended whose suspension is due to nonpayment of fines or DMV required fees. The program is designed to assist individuals in the process of reinstating their driving privilege prior to their trial for driving suspended.

Virginia Code § 46.2-355.1 directs that upon receiving notification of a second conviction for driving while an offender's license, permit or privilege to drive is suspended or revoked will be required to report to a Virginia Alcohol Safety Action Program within sixty days of the date of such notice for intervention. The ASAP representative will review all applicable laws with the person attending the interview, provide guidance with respect to budgeting for payment of court fines and costs, if applicable, and explain the laws and the consequences of future offenses and may refer the person to any driver improvement clinic.

2. Who commands clients to take Intervention Interview?

Intervention Interview is required by the Department of Motor Vehicles (**DMV**) due to a suspended driver's license.

3. How much does Fairfax – ASAP charge for Intervention Interview class?

\$30.00 - **NOT Refundable**. You must register and pay in advance in person or over the phone.

4. What type of media accepted for payment?

Fairfax ASAP accepts only Visa/MasterCard or Money Order – **No Cash or Personal Checks**.

5. How often does Fairfax ASAP provide Intervention Interview Class?

Intervention Interview is scheduled bi-weekly, on Wednesdays at 1:45 pm (Late arrivals will not be admitted).

6. How long is Intervention Interview Class?

Intervention Interview sessions last approximately 1 hour.

7. How many sessions of Intervention Interview does a client need to sign up for?

Intervention Interview is a One-time session. The session consists of review of driving record and a short video. A Probation Officer will be assigned to conduct the session.

8. What will happen after I complete the Intervention Interview session?

After you complete the session, an ASAP staff will update your information and notify the DMV electronically within 24 hours that you completed the Intervention Interview session.

RECKLESS/AGGRESSIVE DRIVER PROGRAM (RADP)

1. What is the Reckless/Aggressive Driver Program?

It is a program for non-alcohol related charges/convictions. Participants in this program usually have charges such as reckless driving, passing on the right, driving too closely, or those driving violations that contribute to aggressive/road rage behaviors. This class teaches participants to handle stress and manage anger while driving. Emphasis is on preventing reckless/aggressive driving and avoiding being a perpetrator or victim of road rage.

2. How long are Reckless/ Aggressive Driver Program?

Reckless/ Aggressive class is 4 hours; however, there is an 8 hour **Driver Improvement Program (DIP) class which is the prerequisite** for taking the Reckless/ Aggressive Driver Program. Reckless/ Aggressive cannot be taken without taking the Driver Improvement Program (DIP).

3. Do I have to take the Driver Improvement Program at Fairfax – ASAP?

No, Driver Improvement Program does not have to be taken at this location. It can be taken at another ASAP or DMV approved locations. A list of locations can be found at the following website:

4. Can I still take the Reckless/ Aggressive Driver Program class at Fairfax – ASAP after I complete the 8 hour Driver Improvement Program elsewhere?

Yes, but you must supply a copy of the Certificate of Completion from a DMV approved DIP class.

5. How much does Fairfax – ASAP charge for the Reckless/ Aggressive Driver Program class?

\$65.00 - **NOT Refundable**. You must register and pay in advance in person or over the phone.

6. What types of payment are accepted?

Fairfax ASAP accepts only Visa/MasterCard or Money Order – **No Cash or Personal Checks**.

7. How often does Fairfax ASAP provide the Reckless/ Aggressive Driver Program class?

Reckless/ Aggressive Driver Program scheduled one Tuesday evening a month, from 6:00 pm – 10:00 pm (Late arrivals will not be admitted).

8. Will I receive a Certificate if I complete the Reckless/ Aggressive Driver Program?

Yes, you MUST have completed 4 hour of the Reckless/ Aggressive class to receive a Certificate of Completion.

DRIVING IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (DIP)

1. What is Driver Improvement Program?

It is a basic driver improvement course available to individuals:

- A. Mandated to attend by DMV as a result of an accumulation of points
 - B. Referred by a court for a traffic violation
- Or
- C. Who volunteer to attend to receive positive points.

2. How much does Fairfax – ASAP charge for the Driver Improvement Program class?

\$75.00 - **NOT Refundable**. You must register and pay in advance in person or over the phone.

3. What types of payment are accepted?

Fairfax ASAP accepts only Visa/MasterCard or Money Order – **No Cash or Personal Checks**.

4. How often does Fairfax ASAP provide Driver Improvement Program class?

Driver Improvement Program is scheduled one Saturday a month, from 8:00 am – 5:00 pm (Late arrivals will not be admitted).

5. Will I receive a Certificate if I complete the Driver Improvement Program?

Yes, you MUST have completed 8 hour of the Driver Improvement Program to receive a Certificate of Completion.
