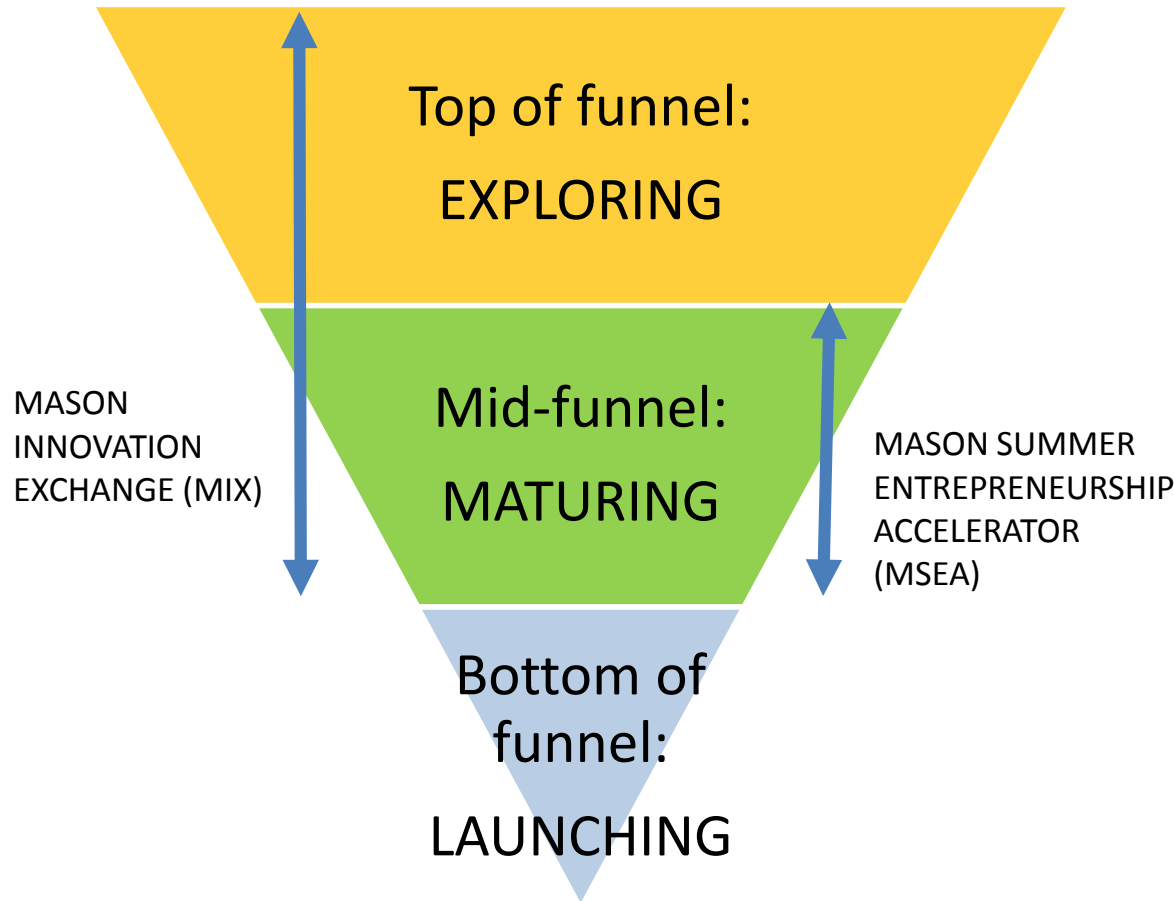

- 7 student teams & 2 faculty teams
