The CCFAC invites you to a public hearing to identify housing and other human service needs to be addressed in the Fairfax County Consolidated Plan One-Year Action Plan for FY 2015 (July 1, 2014-June 30, 2015). The final plan will be approved by the Board of Supervisors and submitted to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) in May 2014.

The hearing is open to the public and the CCFAC is particularly interested in hearing from residents who are in need of housing or other services; local non-profits, faith-based or private enterprise providers of direct services to low-income individuals and families; and advocates for such services.

Participants may comment on the housing, community development and human services needs of the county, including fair housing, as well as provide input on how well the county is performing in meeting these needs. **The CCFAC invites input on *any topic* but specifically** comments on the impact of sequestration and the challenges faced by service providers to meet the needs of their client base.

***Note: The public hearing is not for the purpose of soliciting requests for funding.***
