Primary Elections Scheduled for Aug. 23



Primary elections are being held this coming **Tuesday, August 23**. Polls will be open from 6:00am to 7:00pm. The registration deadline for the primaries has passed.

Absentee votes can still be cast in person at the Fairfax County Government Center, 12000 Government Parkway in Fairfax, Suite 323, **through August 20**. In-person voting is available from 8am to 4:30pm on Monday - Wednesday, from 8am to 7pm on Thursdays, and from 9am to 5pm on **Saturday, August 20**. If you have any questions about absentee ballots, absentee voting or the primary elections, please contact the Office of Elections at 703-222-0776.
