**Bulova Welcomes Intelsat U.S. Headquarters to Tysons**

**December 3, 2012** – Today, Fairfax County Board of Supervisors Chairman Sharon Bulova took part in an economic development announcement regarding Intelsat’s new headquarters in Tysons. Intelsat is one of the world’s leading satellite service companies. Its corporate headquarters is in Luxembourg; the Tysons location will function as the company’s U.S. headquarters.

Intelsat’s move marks the first major corporate location announcement for a new building around one of the Tysons Metro stations. Intelsat will be the anchor tenant for the Tysons Tower, currently under construction. The company will move 432 jobs to Fairfax County from Washington, D.C.

“I think Intelsat’s relocation to Tysons shows that it makes sense for companies to come to Fairfax County and do business,” said Chairman Bulova. “The County is working hard to develop Tysons into a walkable, sustainable, urban 24-hour activity center and this is a great step towards that goal.”

It is anticipated that by 2050, Tysons will be transformed into a walkable, vibrant urban center, with over 100,000 residents and 200,000 jobs.
