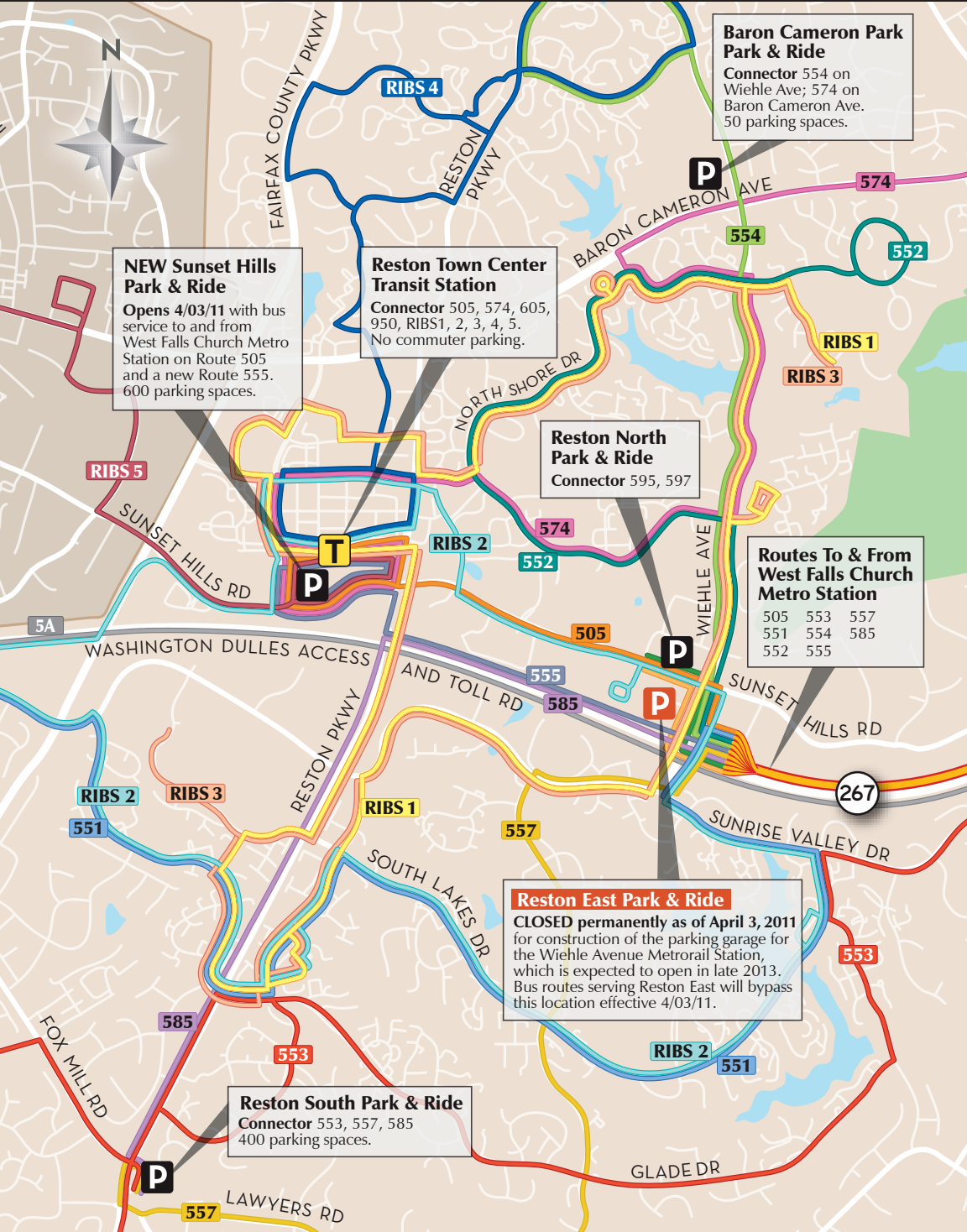


Reston East Park & Ride CLOSSES APRIL 3rd

Parking and Transit Options



NEW Sunset Hills Park & Ride
 Opens 4/03/11 with bus service to and from West Falls Church Metro Station on Route 505 and a new Route 555. 600 parking spaces.

Reston Town Center Transit Station
 Connector 505, 574, 605, 950, RIBS1, 2, 3, 4, 5. No commuter parking.

Reston North Park & Ride
 Connector 595, 597

Baron Cameron Park & Ride
 Connector 554 on Wiehle Ave; 574 on Baron Cameron Ave. 50 parking spaces.

Reston East Park & Ride
CLOSED permanently as of April 3, 2011 for construction of the parking garage for the Wiehle Avenue Metrorail Station, which is expected to open in late 2013. Bus routes serving Reston East will bypass this location effective 4/03/11.

Reston South Park & Ride
 Connector 553, 557, 585
 400 parking spaces.

Reston East Park & Ride will CLOSE permanently on

April 3, 2011 for construction of the parking garage for the Wiehle Avenue Metrorail Station. Bus routes serving Reston East will bypass this location effective 4/03/11, and include routes 505, 551, 552, 554, 557, RIBS 1, RIBS 2, RIBS 3.

OPTIONS FOR RESTON EAST COMMUTERS

- **Sunset Hills Park & Ride will open on April 3, 2011** on Town Center Parkway at the intersection of Sunset Hills Road. Commuters may park and catch the Route 505 bus or a new Route 555 bus direct to and from West Falls Church Metro Station. This parking facility will remain open until the new parking garage for the Wiehle Avenue Metro Station opens in late 2013. Parking is free.
- **Reston South Park & Ride** also has bus service direct to and from West Falls Church Metro Station via Route 585. With routes 553, 557 and 585, there is a bus traveling to/from West Falls Church Metro every 6-8 minutes during peak hours!
- **Commuters may be able to leave their cars at home** if they live near a bus route. Several neighborhood routes will take you to and from West Falls Church Metro (551, 552, 553, 554, 557), while other routes can take you to meet a Metro-bound bus at nearby transfer points.
- **Commuters are encouraged to try biking or walking** to catch the bus, telework, carpools or vanpools, and other alternatives to driving and parking.
