**INDICTMENT** – Two counts of capital murder, one count of 1<sup>st</sup> degree murder, one count of malicious wounding, four counts of use of a firearm in the commission of a felony, and two counts of possession of a firearm as a convicted felon

On December 11, 2014, Bryan Porter, Commonwealth's Attorney, David Lord, Senior Assistant Commonwealth's Attorney, Marc Birnbaum, Office of the Attorney General, Charles Severance, the Defendant, and Megan Thomas, Joseph King, and Chris Leibig, Counsel for the Defendant, appeared before this Court. The Defendant is indicted for two counts of capital murder, one count of 1<sup>st</sup> degree murder, one count of malicious wounding, four counts of use of a firearm in the commission of a felony, and two counts of possession of a firearm as a convicted felon. He appeared while in custody.

Counsel for the Defendant moved the Court to order that a competency evaluation be performed on the Defendant pursuant to § 19.2-169.1 of the 1950 Code of Virginia, as amended. The evaluation shall be performed at the Arlington Detention Center by Dr. Anita Boes, a qualified psychiatrist, clinical psychologist or master's level psychologist who is qualified by training and experience to perform the evaluation, unless hospitalization of the Defendant for an evaluation on competency is necessary.

Based on the representation of Counsel for the Defendant, the Court **ORDERED** that the Defendant be evaluated by pursuant § 19.2-169.1 of the 1950 Code of Virginia, as amended.
