ORDER

This 19th day of March, 2015, came this matter to be heard upon several motions. The Court, having heard the evidence and argument of counsel, made the following rulings:

1. Review of Competency is continued to April 23, 2015, at which time a contested hearing may be held along with additional motions. April 2, 2015 is the deadline for the defendant to notify the Court if competency is contested.
2. The defendant's Motion for Funds is granted, and defense counsel is granted 200 additional hours for continued investigation.
3. The defendant's Motion for Ex Parte Hearing is denied without prejudice.
4. The defendant's Motion to Unshackle the Defendant's Ankles is reserved for defense counsel to file a written motion with the Court.

This case is continued to April 23, May 21, June 25, July 23, and August 13, 2015, for further motions.

The Court certifies that at all times during this hearing the defendant was personally present and his attorney was likewise personally present and capably represented the defendant.

And the defendant is remanded to the custody of the Sheriff.
