ORDER

This 23rd day of April, 2015, came this matter to be heard upon several motions. The Court, having heard the evidence and argument of counsel, made the following rulings:

1. The defendant's Motion to Suppress is denied.
2. The defendant's Motion to Sever is taken under advisement by the Court.
3. The defendant's Bond Motion is withdrawn without prejudice.
4. The defendant's Motion to Dismiss is withdrawn without prejudice.
5. The defendant's Motion for Transcripts of audio/video recording of hearings is granted with respect to witness testimony only.
6. By agreement of counsel, the Court shall review "in camera" the defendant's Motion to Quash Subpoena Duces Tecum regarding medical records from Loudoun Hospital, to disclose only those records pertaining to the defendant's mobility at the relevant time.
7. The defendant's Motion for Unshackled Transport is rendered moot by the change of venue.
8. The defendant's Motion for Funds for Firearms Expert is granted. The Court hereby appoints and authorizes payment to Ann Davis as a firearms expert for the defense, and said funds are not to exceed \$6,250.00 without further leave of the Court.
9. The defendant's Motion for Funds for Identity Expert is denied.

10. The Commonwealth's Motion to Reconsider Presence of a Still Photographer is taken under advisement by the Court.

The Court certifies that at all times during this hearing the defendant was personally present and his attorney was likewise personally present and capably represented the defendant.

And the defendant is remanded to the custody of the Sheriff.
