ORDER

THIS CAUSE came to be heard upon the requests by various media representatives to photograph or film the hearing in this case on November 14, 2014 at 9:00am; and

IT APPEARING to the Court as follows:

1. That The Washington Post filed its written Request on November 6, 2014; and
2. Permitting a representative of the media to photograph and/or video record the hearing should be allowed; and
3. Additional requests by separate media representatives could be served by requiring one photographer to share all photos with the other representatives.

IT IS THEREFORE ADJUDGED, ORDERED AND DECREED:

4. That The Washington Post, or its designee(s), are permitted to bring one still photography camera and one video camera to the November 14th hearing in this case, and The Washington Post shall coordinate pool coverage amongst other interested media, through the Virginia Association of Broadcasters and Virginia Press Association or other means of distribution, to all other media members belonging to those organizations; and
5. Media representatives may request from the Circuit Court Technology Office, and receive upon payment of applicable fees, a CDAR audio recording of the November 14th hearing, provided that such recording may be used in news reports but shall not be reproduced for distribution to the general public.
