Utilization Management Review: February 2010

LIPOS:

- 14 admissions for 53 bed days
- 291 admissions for 1,263 bed days YTD
- Monthly average admission of 36 is identical to FY09 monthly average (36)
- Admissions are predominantly CMA (38%) and Voluntary (36%)
- Average LOS of 4.3 days is lower than the average LOS for FY09 (5.2 days)
- 21 consumers used LIPOS more than once in FY10
- 31 consumers stayed between 8-11 days, 9 stayed 12-17 days, one stayed 22 days YTD
- Mt. Vernon Hospital has the highest number of admissions (33%)

NVMHI:

- 85 admissions for this month; 649 admissions YTD
- For this month, 25 TDO admissions (29%)
- For this month, 25 insured admissions (29%): 14 direct TDOs (56%), 6 (24%) voluntary, 4 post-hearing admissions (16%), 1 NGRI (4%)
- Monthly average admission of 81 is somewhat lower than FY09 average (85)
- Admissions YTD are TDO (30%), Involuntary (26%), Voluntary (22%), CMA (20%)
- Average (mean) LOS for 649 discharges YTD = 61 days; average (median) LOS YTD = 7 days
- Transfers from LIPOS bed to NVMHI YTD: 45%; higher than FY09 (33%)
- Average LOS of LIPOS transfers = 13 days
- Occupancy rate for this month: 91% (FY09 = 93%)
- 30 day re-admission rate for this month: 9% (7 re-admissions in January); FY09 = 11%
- EBL decreased to 30 by the end of this month; 0 consumers added; 3 consumers discharged
- 4 ID admissions this month; FY10 = 12; FY09 = 13

TDO/Commitments:

- 162 commitment hearings this month; 1,569 YTD
- Monthly average commitment hearings of 196 is somewhat lower than FY09 average (199)
- 40% are CMAed, 34% are Committed, 24% are Dismissed, 2% are MOT (36 YTD)
- 1,606 TDO consumers YTD were sent primarily to Mt. Vernon (21%)
- 1,156 commitment/CMA consumers YTD were sent primarily to NVMHI (33%)
- 62% of Commitment/CMA consumers have insurance; 23% sent to state facility have insurance
- 94 TDO admissions to out of area hospitals YTD (33 to Poplar Springs, 29 to CCCA, 8 to VTC, 4 to Snowden); 13 this month

Crisis Care:

- 50 admissions and 49 discharges this month; 443 admissions and 418 discharges YTD
- 60% are diversion, 37% are step-down; 2% are respite, 1% are TDO; no NGRI admissions
- Monthly average admission rate of 55 is substantially higher than average for FY09 (42)
- 38% had SA diagnosis; 35% were homeless at admission
- 78% had a planned discharge; 7% were hospitalized
- 45 consumers (10% of admissions) stayed longer than 21 days YTD
- 35% had Medicaid; 59% had no insurance
- 82% occupancy for this month

Older Adults:

- 5 consumers at ESH, 3 are Ready for Discharge
- 26 consumers at Piedmont; 6 are Ready for Discharge; 7 admissions and 6 discharges YTD
- RAFT census: 8 in ALFs, 3 in supported homes, 4 in nursing homes; 4 rehospitalizations YTD
- RAFT waiting list: 2 for ALF, 7 for nursing home


