



Northern Virginia Family Service Fairfax Accessible Medication Program

Many pharmaceutical companies offer **free** prescription medication to persons who are low-income and either have no health insurance or have no prescription coverage. The **Fairfax Accessible Medication Program** provides a caseworker that will assist you in completing initial and refill applications for these medications.

All medication is ordered directly from the Pharmaceutical Company that produces the medication. Most medications ordered through our program will arrive in 30 to 45 days. There is no cost for our services. The medications will be delivered to your physician.

This service is available **only for medication taken for chronic illness.**

Client Eligibility:

- Live in Fairfax County, the City of Fairfax, or the City of Falls Church;
- Currently take medication for a chronic illness such as diabetes, high blood pressure, or heart disease. (The program does not provide assistance for medications taken on a one time basis, such as antibiotics, and does not pay for prescriptions up front);
- Have a current prescription from a physician;
- No health insurance or prescription coverage – Medicare recipients are eligible
- Have a family income within the guidelines set by the pharmaceutical companies. (Income includes Social Security, pension, retirement, wages, and spousal income.)

*a single person's income must be \$1,815 or less per month

*a family of two's income must be \$2,452 or less per month
