

WHAT WE DO

Assist individuals in a variety of approved and appropriate tasks free of charge, including:

- Grocery shopping.
- Transportation to medical appointments, the bank, library and for quick errands.
- Light house maintenance such as changing light bulbs, small painting jobs, minor repairs.
- Telephone reassurance and friendly visits.
- Organizational tasks like helping fill out paperwork or organizing storage areas.
- Read and write letters and other correspondence.

WE NEED VOLUNTEERS WHO:

- Are at least 18 years old, or school-aged with the full assistance of a parent or legal guardian.
- Can successfully complete the required background checks.
- Have the ability to establish and maintain a good relationship with clients.
- Are willing to work within Fairfax County and the cities of Fairfax and Falls Church.
- Can work a varied schedule, including weekends and evenings, depending on the needs of our clients.
- No regular schedule required.
