The Katherine K. Hanley Family Shelter, an integral part of the county's plan to end homelessness, will accommodate up to 20 families at a time, providing temporary shelter as families move toward self-sufficiency and permanent housing. The shelter is located at the intersection of Route 29 and Meadow Estates Road in Centreville and is operated by Shelter House, Inc.



No parking is available at the site of the ribbon cutting ceremony. Attendees are asked to park in the front parking lot of the Pennino Building (12011 Government Center Parkway). Fastran buses will transport attendees to the site beginning at 10:15 a.m. and will return them to the Pennino Building after the ceremony.

There will be tours of the facility and light refreshments served from noon - 2 p.m.
