**NOTICE OF A PROPOSED ADOPTION OF A RESOLUTION
APPROPRIATING SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDS FOR FAIRFAX COUNTY, VIRGINIA
FOR THE TWELVE-MONTH PERIOD BEGINNING JULY 1, 2002
AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2003**

Notice is hereby given in accordance with Section 15.2-2507 of the Code of Virginia that at a regular meeting of the Urban County Board of Supervisors of Fairfax County, Virginia, held in the Board Auditorium of the Fairfax County Government Center at 12000 Government Center Parkway, Fairfax, Virginia, on Monday, March 24, 2003, it was proposed to adopt a supplemental appropriation of funds for Fairfax County, Virginia for the twelve-month period beginning July 1, 2002, and ending June 30, 2003, and Clerk of said Board was directed to advertise the proposed resolution with notice that the Board will hold a public hearing on the same at a regular meeting to be held in the Board Auditorium of the Fairfax County Government Center on April 7, 8 and 9, 2003 at 7:30 p.m., at which time, persons affected may be heard on said resolution.

* As a result of these adjustments, the FY 2003 General Fund non-recurring Available Balance is \$2,870,520. It should be noted that according to the Budget Guidelines established by the Board of Supervisors, 40% of the balance will be allocated to the Revenue Stabilization Fund. Of the remaining balance, 50% is allocated to the Schools for non-recurring requirements. The remaining \$0.85 million will be allocated at the discretion of the Board of Supervisors.
