COUNTY USE OF SCHOOL SPACE

County Departments	Usage/Challenges
Department of Family Services	School Age Child Care (SACC) at 137 Fairfax County Public School sites.
	Higher Horizons and Gum Springs Centers - two FCPS preschool special education teachers are deployed to these sites
Park Authority	Park Authority classes throughout the school year and camps and RecPAC during summer months at various different sites.
Office of Elections	Polling places located in 163 schools and school owned facilities.
Health Department	Space for School Nurse to provide patient care – all schools.
	Office of Emergency Preparedness uses High Schools and Middle Schools for trainings, exercises, and during emergencies. Community use makes finding space in schools challenging.
Neighborhood and Community Services	Gyms and fields at all facilities for recreation programs.
	Computer Learning Center Programs (CLCP) at: Annandale Terrace, Mt. Vernon Woods, Hybla Valley Elementary School. Space is sometimes limited
	Teen Programs
	Therapeutic Recreation Services (TRS). Storage of TRS supplies can be an issue as space is limited.
	Pimmit Hills Senior Center
	Alternative House for Targeted Youth at Annandale High School
	Miscellaneous other special programs
Reston Community Center	Recreation programs, summer camps, and special programs at various schools.
Police Department	FCPS provides the Police School Liaison Commander a computer, office space, administrative support, and use of common areas.
	School Resource Officers (SRO) are assigned to all High Schools, Secondary and Middle Schools. Access to an area for administrative duties is provided.
Community Services Board	Various treatment programs in centers and schools. Some confidentiality and client management issues can occur.
Department of Information Technology	Bus radio services provided by Department of Information Technology at the Jermantown garage.

School Departments	Usage/Challenges
Student Athletics & Activities	Athletic Fields: Many Park Authority fields are used by various High Schools during the Fall and Spring seasons Monday – Friday.
	Cross Country activities at 23 Schools, plus 25 major meets use about 10 Park Authority sites.
	Tennis activities conducted by 7 schools at 7 Parks.
	Swim and Dive Practice: 23 High Schools use Park Authority pools
	Golf: High Schools use all 7 golf sites for golf team tryouts, practices, matches, as well as end of season district and regional tournaments
Financial Services	Logistics Distribution Center, Warehouse Space, is shared with the Schools and several County agencies, Department of Purchasing and Supply Management and the Park Authority.
Facilities & Transportation Services	School bus parking at Government Center, Laurel Hill and closed I-66 Landfill.
Instructional Services	Adult Community Education (ACE) at Fairfax County Government Center, Mott and James Lee Community Centers, Willston Center, Hollin Hall Senior Center and various other community, senior and library centers, as needed.
Special Services	GED Programming at North County Government Center, Historic Fairfax Courthouse, Adult Detention Center, James Lee Community Center and Heritage Building-Annandale.
	Transitional Support Resource Center at South County Government Center, East County Probation Office, Historic Fairfax Courthouse Heritage Building-Annandale, YMCA-Reston and Spring Village Job Site-Springfield.
	Falls Bridge School, Gunston School, Independent Study Program, Hillwood School and Sager School (Direct teacher instruction for students assigned to this site by the Court) at North County Government Center, South County Government Center, East County Probation Office, Historic Fairfax Courthouse and Juvenile Shelter Care.
	Northwest Center School (Direct teacher instruction for secondary students placed for mental health reasons at the day treatment center) at North County Government Center.
	Student Registration at South County Government Center.
	ESOL Assessment Center at South County Government Center.
	Independent Study Program (Direct teacher instruction for students assigned to this site by the Court) at South County Government Center and Historic Fairfax Courthouse.
	Department of Special Services-Department of Neighborhood and Community Services Joint Project-Opportunity Neighborhood Governance Team at South County Government Center.

	Skills Resource Center and other DSS programming offering advancement toward a High School diploma at the Juvenile Detention Center, Adult Detention Center, and the Heritage Building in Annandale.
	Boys and Girls Probation House - School program for secondary male and female students assigned to these residential facilities.
	Leland House- School program for students in residence for short term critical mental health treatment (Community Services Board location).
	Sojourn House-School program provided for secondary school-aged females in residence for mental health treatment (Community Services Board location).
	Crossroads-School program to provide academic support to school-aged students in residence for substance abuse treatment (Community Services Board location).
	Horizons-School program to provide academic support to school-aged students in day treatment for substance abuse (Community Services Board location).
	Neighborhood School Readiness Team Meetings at ten libraries: George Mason, Reston, Tysons-Pimmit, Burke, Sherwood, Martha Washington, Centreville, Oakton, Richard Byrd, and Thomas Jefferson.
	GIVE Tutoring at five libraries: Richard Byrd, Herndon Fortnightly, Centreville, Thomas Jefferson, and Woodrow Wilson.
	Rose Hill ESOL Pre-School Program at John Marshall 3 days per week; Head Start Waitlist Program at Thomas Jefferson and Reston Libraries; Literacy Programs, Preschool through Elementary School workshops, FCPS parent ESL, tutoring at various Libraries; and County Parking agreement between Woodrow Wilson Library and Baileys Elementary
	Classroom space at the Historic Courthouse, the North, South and East County Probation unit offices, the Juvenile Detention Center, Shelter Care II and Foundations are used on a weekly basis for FCPS Alternative School programs
