

ADDENDUM NO. 2

This Addendum consists of a total of four (4) pages.

This Addendum is supplementary to the Contract Documents for **ANNUAL CONTRACT FOR TRANSPORTATION CONSTRUCTION SERVICES, CONTRACT NO. CN14304064**, Fairfax County, Virginia.

All clarifications, changes, additions or deletions included herein as **Addendum No. 2** shall become a part of the Contract Documents as if originally called for in the Drawings, Specifications and Form of Bid.

Q1: Construction Survey Services: What do they encompass and will they be coordinated with the Contractor?

A1. Construction survey services will be provided by the County and may include stakeout of base-line, cutsheets for curbs, storm and utility lines, Limits of Disturbance, Limits of Grading, Limits of Clearing, As-built, and other services requested by the Contractor deemed necessary to execute the scope of work required for each authorized task order. All survey requests will be initiated by the Contractor and processed by the project manager and the project inspector.

Q-2: If encountered, how will Rock Excavation be classified to determine payment?

A-2: A new pay item, Item #274, "Rock Excavation" has been added to the Form of Bid. Please refer to Section 2300 for detail on the definition of Rock Excavation and how it will be paid.

Remove Page B-27 from the Form of Bid and replace it with Attachment-1 included with this Addendum.

Q-3: *Paragraph 4.8.6 of Section D calls for test holes to determine the location of utilities. How will the Contractor be compensated?*

A-3: A new pay item, Item #275, “Test holes for Utilities Location” has been added to the Form of Bid. See Attachment -1 of this Addendum.

Q-4: *What specifics are required for Quality Control? Since the scope and duration of each Task Order is unknown making it difficult to price accurately. Will there be an allowance or at least additional description?*

A-4: The contractor’s unit pricing is to include all required statutory and regulatory testing. The owner reserves the right to perform additional testing at Owner’s cost.

Q-5: *What process will the County use to address and scope work on task orders that is not covered by the bid item list?*

A-5: The scope and cost for new items not included in the Form of Bid will be evaluated and mutually agreed to by both the County and the Contractor. For additional information on Change Order Work, please refer to Section D of the bid document, Paragraph 8.4 of Article 8: Contract Time and Article 12: Changes and Modifications in the Work

Q-6: *How will contaminated and Hazardous Materials, if encountered, be measured and paid?*

A-6: If encountered, a change order for Hazardous Materials will be processed as described in Paragraph 12.9, Subsurface Conditions Found Different. The method of measuring the material and the cost associated with the change order item for removal and disposal will be mutually agreed to by both the County and the Contractor.

Q-7: *Section A-10 (Page A-6): Security for Faithfull Performance, calls for Performance Bond and Labor and Material Payment Bond of a 100% of the contract value. This is excessive.*

A-7: With this Addendum No. 2, the first sentence of Paragraph A-10.A has been changed to read as follows:

The Successful Bidder shall furnish a Performance Bond and Labor and Material Payment Bond, each in the amount equal to twenty percent (20%) of the Contract Sum as security for the faithful performance of this Contract and as
