**DEAD RUN FORCE MAIN RAHABILITATION

Sealed bids are hereby solicited for the **Dead Run Force Main Rehabilitation Project**. The Dead Run Force Main Rehabilitation project consists of the rehabilitation of the existing 14-inch cast iron pipe (CIP) force main located on Churchill Road between Dead Run Drive and Fleetwood Drive in McLean, Virginia (Tax Map Nos. 21-4 and 30-2) in the Dranesville District. The Work shall include the following:

1. The construction of a temporary 14-inch HDPE sewer bypass line.
2. The lining of the existing 14-inch cast iron pipe (CIP) force main.
3. The removal of the temporary 14-inch HDPE sewer bypass line (except in areas as shown on the plans).
4. Directional drilling as shown on the plans.
5. Site work will include tree removal, erosion and sedimentation control measures, removal and replacement of signs and mailboxes, replacing old culverts with new CMP/RCP culverts as shown on the plans, ditch restoration, driveway/roadway repaving as required by VDOT, and all other related work.

This is a **unit** price Contract. Contract length is 150 calendar days.

Bids will be received in the office of the Director, Utilities Design and Construction Division, Department of Public Works and Environmental Services, 12000 Government Center Parkway, Suite 463, Fairfax, Virginia until **11 a.m.** prevailing local time, **Tuesday, January 5, 2016**. Bids received after that time will not be accepted. Bids will be opened publicly and read aloud **at 11:05, a.m., Tuesday, January 5, 2016**, in the Fourth Floor Conference Room, Suite 463, 12000 Government Center Parkway, Fairfax, Virginia 22035-0056. **All bidders shall comply with Article A-21, Fairfax County Construction Safety Resolution. Bidder's request for determination of eligibility to bid must be received by the County no later than fourteen (14) days before bids are due in accordance to Article A-18.E of Section A, information For Bidders.**

A Pre-Bid Conference will be held on **Tuesday, December 15, 2015**, at **9 a.m.** in the Fourth Floor Conference Room, **Suite 463**, 12000 Government Center Parkway, Fairfax, Virginia 22035-0056. All bona fide bidders are requested to attend.
