Sealed bids are hereby solicited for construction of approximately 1,765 linear feet of 6' wide stone dust walkway connection along Georgetown Pike. Miscellaneous scope of work includes storm drainage structures, demolition and replacement of existing site improvements and erosion and sediment control measures.

This is a Unit price Contract. Contract length is 120 calendar days.

This is a Federally Funded Project, Davis Bacon, Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE), and related acts apply. Refer to www.dmb.state.va.us for DBE certified businesses.

Bids will be received in the office of the Director, Utilities Design and Construction Division, Department of Public Works and Environmental Services, 12000 Government Center Parkway, Suite 463, Fairfax, Virginia until **11:00 a.m.**, prevailing local time, **Wednesday, October 22, 2014**. Bids received after that time will not be accepted. Bids will be opened publicly and read aloud at **11:05 am, Wednesday, October 22, 2014**, in the Fourth Floor Conference Room, Suite 463, 12000 Government Center Parkway, Fairfax, Virginia 22035-0056.

All bidders shall comply with Article A-21, Fairfax County Construction Safety Resolution. Bidder's request for determination of eligibility to bid must be received by the County no later than fourteen (14) days before bids are due in accordance to Article A-18.E of Section A, Information For Bidders.

A Pre-Bid Conference will be held on **Wednesday, October 8, 2014**, at **10:00 a.m.**, in the Fourth Floor Conference Room, **Suite 463**, 12000 Government Center Parkway, Fairfax, Virginia 22035-0056. All bona fide bidders are requested to attend.
