**ADVERTISEMENT FOR BID**

**WOODGLEN LAKE DREDGING AND RESTORATION**

**CONTRACT NO. CN14125106**

**PROJECT NO. SD-000033-021**

Sealed bids are hereby solicited for mechanically dredging 34,800 CY of sediment from Woodglen Lake in Fairfax County. Bidders may select one of two options:

- Option 1 - draining the lake entirely; then excavating, hauling and disposing of the sediment or,
- Option 2 - partially draining the lake, as required for the in-lake construction; then excavating, hauling and disposing of the wet sediment.

Additional items of work (required for both options) include: improvements to an existing temporary access road; site preparation; erosion and sediment control; demolition and grading of an existing decanting basin; construction of a forebay berm (the in-lake construction noted above); stream restoration; site restoration; and construction of a permanent access road.

This is a **Unit Price** Contract. The contract length of the project is **160** calendar days.

Bids will be received in the office of the Director, Construction Management Division, Department of Public Works and Environmental Services, 12000 Government Center Parkway, Suite 463, Fairfax, Virginia until **11:00 a.m.**, prevailing local time, **Thursday, August 21, 2014**. Bids received after that time will not be accepted. Bids will be opened publicly and read aloud at **11:05 a.m., Thursday, August 21, 2014** in the Fourth Floor Conference Room, Suite 463, 12000 Government Center Parkway, Fairfax, Virginia 22035-0056.

**All bidders shall comply with Article A-21, Fairfax County Construction Safety Resolution. Bidder's request for determination of eligibility to bid must be received by the County no later than fourteen (14) days before bids are due in accordance to Article A-18.E of Section A, Information For Bidders.**

A **Mandatory** Pre-Bid Conference will be held on **Tuesday, August 12, 2014** at **10:00 a.m.**, in the Fourth Floor Conference Room, **Suite 463**, 12000 Government Center Parkway, Fairfax, Virginia. All bona fide bidders are required to attend. **Failure to attend the Pre-Bid Conference will result in rejection of the bid.**

**Contractors bidding on this project must meet minimum experience requirements defined in Article A-4.F of Section A, Information for Bidders.**
